Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking – Pringdale Gardens Circle

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Scarborough Community Council to introduce overnight on-street permit parking on Pringdale Gardens Circle, east of Danforth Road, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., seven days a week.

Area residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Pringdale Gardens Circle to accommodate their long term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement Officers.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Manager, Permit and Enforcement – Parking, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council prohibit parking except by permit from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily, on a street-name basis, on the south side of the northerly east-west leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle, from Danforth Road to the east side of the easterly north-south leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle, and on the south side of the southerly east-west leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle, from the west side of the westerly north-south leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle to the east side of the easterly north-south leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle.

2. Scarborough Community Council prohibit Standing at all times on the north side of the northerly east-west leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle, from Danforth Road to the east side of the easterly north-south leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle, on the north side of the southerly east-west leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle, from the west side of the westerly north-south leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle to the east side of the easterly north-south leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle, and on both sides of the westerly and easterly north-south legs of Pringdale Gardens Circle, from the northerly east-west leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle to the southerly east-west leg of Pringdale Gardens Circle.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial cost of installing the required signs on Pringdale Gardens Circle is approximately \$ 5,600.00. All costs associated with the necessary signage installations are included within the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget, within Cost Centres TP0397.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

A request was received from Councillor Michael Thompson, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program on Pringdale Gardens Circle, to accommodate their long term parking needs.

Existing Conditions

Pringdale Gardens Circle, is a local roadway operating in a two-way east/westbound/ and north/southbound direction with a pavement width of 8.5 metres. There is no TTC service on Pringdale Gardens Circle.

Parking is permitted for a maximum 3-hour duration on both sides of Pringdale Gardens Circle.

Analysis

Under the provisions of Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, we are required to conduct a poll of the residents to determine if there is support to introduce permit parking.

Ballots were mailed on December 4, 2018, with the last day for filing a response being January 2, 2019. The results of the poll are as follows:

The majority of area residents who returned their ballots are in favour of the introduction of overnight on-street permit parking on Pringdale Gardens Circle, between north leg of Danforth Road and south leg of Danforth Road.

Transportation Services has no objections to the implementation of permit parking on Pringdale Gardens Circle, east of Danforth Road and and Standing prohibitions at any time on all other sections of Pringdale Gardens Circle.
