

**REPORT FOR ACTION****Stopping Prohibition - Upper Rouge Trail**

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This report recommends prohibiting stopping during the weekday morning and afternoon peak periods on the east side of Upper Rouge Trail, opposite Alvin Curling Public School. Currently, parking is prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on the east side of Upper Rouge Trail.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the east side of Upper Rouge Trail (north-south leg), between a point 15 metres north of Antelope Drive and a point 30 metres further north.
2. Scarborough Community Council prohibit stopping 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year inclusive, on the east side of Upper Rouge Trail (north-south leg), between a point 15 metres north of Antelope Drive and a point 30 metres further north.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial cost of installing the subject recommended signs is approximately \$400.00. The funding for the signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2019 Operating Budget, within Cost Centre TP0397.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

As a result of a request from Councillor Jennifer McKelvie, Transportation Services staff reviewed the feasibility of changing the parking regulations on Upper Rouge Trail, fronting Alvin Curling Public School.

Currently, standing is prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on the west side (school side) of Upper Rouge Trail. Parking is prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on the east side (opposite side of school) of Upper Rouge Trail.

Existing Conditions

The following characteristics describe Upper Rouge Trail and the surrounding area:

- Upper Rouge Trail and Antelope Drive are located north of Sheppard Avenue East and east of Morningside Avenue.
- Upper Rouge Trail and Antelope Drive are two-lane local roads with a pavement width of approximately 8.5 metres.
- Sidewalks are located on at least one side of Upper Rouge Trail and on Antelope Drive.
- Alvin Curling Public School is located at 50 Upper Rouge Trail on the west side of Upper Rouge Trail.
- The land use on Upper Rouge Trail and on Antelope Drive consists of single family residential dwellings.

Transportation Services has determined that it is feasible to prohibit stopping from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on the east side of Upper Rouge Trail, opposite Alvin Curling Public School. The proposed No Stopping regulation will be consistent with the existing stopping prohibitions on the south side of Upper Rouge Trail and on the north side of Antelope Drive in the vicinity of the school. The proposed stopping prohibition is anticipated to enhance sight lines, reduce congestion, and maintain the flow of traffic on Upper Rouge Trail and on Antelope Drive.
