

**REPORT FOR ACTION****Standing Prohibition - Scottfield Drive**

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This report recommends prohibiting standing at all times on the south side of Scottfield Drive, between Middlefield Road and Finch Avenue East. Currently, parking is permitted for a maximum period of three hours on both sides of Scottfield Drive.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the south side of Scottfield Drive, between a point 62 metres east of Middlefield Road and a point 49 metres further east.
2. Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the south side of Scottfield Drive, between a point 239 metres east of Middlefield Road and a point 52 metres further east.
3. Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing standing prohibition in effect at all times on the south side of Scottfield Drive, between a point 138 metres east of Middlefield Road and a point 78 metres further east.
4. Scarborough Community Council prohibit standing at all times on the south side of Scottfield Drive, between Middlefield Road and Finch Avenue East.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial cost of installing related signage is approximately \$2,000.00. The funding for the signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

As a result of a request from Councillor Cynthia Lai in response to a petition submitted by the businesses on the south side of Scottfield Drive, Transportation Services staff reviewed the feasibility of prohibiting standing at all times on the south side of Scottfield Drive, between Middlefield Road and Finch Avenue East.

Existing Conditions

The following characteristics describe Scottfield Drive:

- Scottfield Drive is located east of Middlefield Road and south of Finch Avenue East.
- Scottfield Drive is a two-lane local road with a regulatory speed limit of 50 km/h.
- Currently, parking is permitted for a maximum period of three hours on both sides of Scottfield Drive except in posted No Parking Anytime or No Standing Anytime areas near driveways.
- Industrial businesses are located on the south side of Scottfield Drive.
- Sidewalks are located on both sides of Scottfield Drive.
- The land use in this area consists mainly of industrial businesses and a long term care facility.

A staff review confirmed that vehicles are being parked beside the business driveways. These parked vehicles restrict access for vehicles and transport trucks entering and exiting the driveways and create a sightline obstruction for motorists and pedestrians.

Transportation Services staff have determined that it is feasible to prohibit standing at all times on the south side of Scottfield Drive, between Middlefield Road and Finch Avenue East.

The proposed No Standing Anytime zone will allow clear and unrestricted access to the business driveways, enhance sightlines and will be enforceable by Toronto Police Services.
