Standing Prohibition - Chancery Lane

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This report recommends prohibiting standing at all times on the west side of Chancery Lane, between Guildwood Parkway and Cadbury Court. Currently, parking is prohibited from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on both sides of this street.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on both sides of Chancery Lane, between Guildwood Parkway and Toynbee Trail.
2. Scarborough Community Council prohibit parking from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the east side of Chancery Lane, between Guildwood Parkway and Cadbury Court.
3. Scarborough Community Council prohibit standing at all times on the west side of Chancery Lane, between Guildwood Parkway and Cadbury Court.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost of installing the required signs is approximately \$400. Funding for these signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

As a result of a request from Councillor Paul Ainslie on behalf of area residents, Transportation Services staff reviewed the feasibility of prohibiting standing at all times on the west side of Chancery Lane, between Guildwood Parkway and Cadbury Court. Currently, parking is prohibited from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on both sides of Chancery Lane between Guildwood Parkway and Cadbury Court.

Existing Conditions

The following characteristics describe Chancery Lane and the surrounding area:

- Chancery Lane is located north of Guildwood Parkway, south of Kingston Road, and west of Morningside Avenue.
- Chancery Lane is a two-lane local road with a regulatory speed limit of 50 km/h. There are no sidewalks on both sides of Chancery Lane.
- The land use in this area consists of single family residential dwellings.

Based on a staff review, it was confirmed that vehicles are parked or stopped on both sides of Chancery Lane, between Guildwood Parkway and Cadbury Court. The parked vehicles restricted the flow of traffic, and created a sight-line obstruction for motorists and pedestrians.

Transportation Services staff have determined that it is feasible to prohibit standing at all times on the west side of Chancery Lane, between Guildwood Parkway and Cadbury Court.

The proposed standing prohibition is anticipated to enhance sightlines, reduce congestion, and maintain the flow of traffic on Chancery Lane.
