Permanent Closure of Portions of Ten Public Highways within Rouge Park for Inclusion in the Newly Created Rouge National Urban Park

SUMMARY

In 2014, City Council authorized the City of Toronto (the "City") to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") providing for the transfer of certain City-owned lands, including portions of ten public highways, to Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada ("HMQ") as represented by the Minister of the Environment for the purposes of the Parks Canada Agency ("Parks Canada") for inclusion in the Rouge National Urban Park ("RNUP"). Transportation Services recommends that the said portions of the ten public highways be permanently closed.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that:

- 1. City Council authorize the permanent closure of the portions of the ten public highways within Rouge National Urban Park, individually identified on Attachment 1 Appendix "A" (the "Highways"), attached to the report dated October 17, 2019, from the Director, Transportation Planning and Capital Program, Transportation Services; and
- 2. City Council enact the by-law substantially in the form of the draft by-law attached as Attachment 2 Appendix "B" attached to the report dated October 17, 2019, from the Director, Transportation Planning and Capital Program, Transportation Services: and
- 3. City Council enact the by-law substantially in the form of the draft by-law attached as Attachment 2 Appendix "C" attached to the report dated October 17, 2019, from the Director, Transportation Planning and Capital Program, Transportation Services; and

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The closing of the Highways will not result in any costs to the City as all costs associated with the closure of the Highways are the responsibility of Parks Canada.

The Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer has reviewed this report and agrees with the financial impact information.

DECISION HISTORY

By Item EX38.4, City Council authorized the City to enter into the MOA with certain parties, including HMQ for the purposes of the RNUP, providing for, amongst other things, the transfer of the Highways to HMQ for incorporation into the RNUP.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services has reviewed the feasibility of closing the Highways and has determined that the Highways can be closed and transferred to HMQ for inclusion in RNUP, subject to the reservation of permanent easements to be granted to the public utilities, as set out in the comments section of Appendix "A".

The highway closing process requires approval from City Council. The draft by-laws are in the Appendices to this report that recommends the closure of these Highways and is tabled at the same Scarborough Community Council meeting at which the public has the opportunity to speak to the matter if they wish to do so.

The requirements of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for Schedule "A+" activities will be met during the posting of the public notice on the notices page of the City's web site for at least five (5) working days prior to the Scarborough Community Council meeting at which the proposed by-laws to close the Highways will be considered.





Attachment 3 - Appendix "L" - 3 (2) Sketch No. PS-2013-014 and R-Plan 66R-30400






Attachment 3 - Appendix "L" - 3 (3) Sketch No. PS-2012-119 and R-Plan 66R-26584













Attachment 3 - Appendix "L" - 3 (5) Sketch No. PS-2013-015 and R-Plan 66R-29763







Attachment 3 - Appendix "L" - 3 (6) Sketch No. PS-2012-117 and R-Plan 66R-29781









