

Parking Amendments - Warren Road

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City Policy or by-laws.

Transportation Services is requesting approval to implement a "No Stopping, Anytime" regulation on the west side of Warren Road, south of St. Clair Avenue West. This is in response to complaints about vehicles parking in the existing "No Parking, Anytime" area which will discourage illegal parking and eliminate any vehicles that are parked with accessible permits. This proposal would not result in the loss of any parking spaces on Warren Road.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the west side of Warren Road, between St. Clair Avenue West and a point 35.1 metres further south.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit stopping at all times on the west side of Warren Road, between St. Clair Avenue West and a point 35.1 metres further south.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All cost associated with the necessary signage installation are included within the Transportation Services 2019 Interim Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Warren Road, between Lynwood Avenue and St. Clair Avenue West, operates two-way on a pavement width of 7.3 metres and a maximum speed limit of 30 km/h. There is no TTC service provided on Warren Road. The following parking regulations are generally in effect on Warren Road, between Lynwood Avenue and St. Clair Avenue West:

East side

- No parking, anytime.

West side

- Maximum one hour parking, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; and
- Three-hour maximum parking, all other times (unsigned, statutory).

The area on the west side of Warren Road, between St. Clair Avenue West and a point 35.1 metres further south has a "No Parking, Anytime" regulation. Our review confirmed the presence of illegal parking and vehicles that are parked with accessible permits in this area.

Transportation Services staff investigated the feasibility of prohibiting stopping on the west side of Warren Road, south of St. Clair Avenue West. Based on our review and consultation with Councillor Josh Matlow, we can support the installation of a "No Stopping, Anytime" prohibition, between St. Clair Avenue West and a point 35.1 metres further south. This will discourage illegal parking and eliminate any vehicles that are parked with accessible permits in this area. This proposal would not result in the loss of any parking spaces on Warren Road.

Councillor Josh Matlow has been advised of the recommendations of this staff report.
