

Installation/Removal of On-Street Accessible Parking Spaces - May 2019 (Delegated)

SUMMARY

This staff report concerns a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision. The purpose is to obtain approval for the installation/removal of a number of on-street accessible parking spaces.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces at the locations identified in Appendix A attached to the report dated May 31, 2019 from the Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funds in the estimated amount of \$6,000.00 are included within the Transportation Services Division's 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses an ongoing initiative.

The Transportation Services Division receives a number of requests for the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces for persons with disabilities. Some of these requests come directly from members of the public and others are received through the local Councillors' offices.

The installation of designated on-street accessible parking spaces is a convenience provided for people with disabilities and/or those who transport them, making it easier for them to find available parking as near as possible to their places of residence or intended destinations and reducing the distances that the disabled people must walk. Delays in installing these on-street accessible spaces may create hardships for disabled applicants.

Timely removal of designated on-street accessible parking spaces when these spaces are no longer required is necessary in order to maximize available on-street parking for other residents/motorists.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services staff have investigated the feasibility of installing/removing on-street accessible parking spaces at the locations identified in Appendix A included in this report. None of these sections of roadway are served by TTC transit routes.

For locations where on-street accessible parking spaces are being established, all applicants are holders of valid Accessible Parking Permits issued by the Ministry of Transportation and each designated space will not result in the loss of more than one on-street parking space for general use. Locations where on-street accessible parking spaces are being removed are the result of applicants moving, holding expired permits or no longer requiring these on-street parking spaces. In certain instances, existing accessible parking spaces may be relocated for technical or operational reasons.

On-street accessible parking spaces to be removed:

Ward	Location
4	Pearson Avenue, south side, between a point 57.2 metres east of Roncesvalles Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east
9	Perth Avenue, west side, between a point 22.5 metres north of Kingsley Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north
9	Salem Avenue, east side, between a point 67 metres north of Hallam Street and a point 5.5 metres further north, from December 1 to March 31, and from the 1 st day to the 15 th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
9	Salem Avenue, west side, between a point 65 metres north of Hallam Street and a point 5.5 metres further north, from the 16 th day to the last day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
9	Salem Avenue, east side, between a point 16.8 metres south of Dupont Street and a point 5.5 metres further south, from December 1 to March 31, and from the 1 st day to the 15 th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
9	Salem Avenue, west side, between a point 25.8 metres south of Dupont Street and a point 5.1 metres further south, from the 16 th day to the last day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
11	Palmerston Avenue, east side, between a point 229.4 metres south of College Street and a point 5.5 metres further south
11	Palmerston Avenue, west side, between a point 229.3 metres south of College Street and a point 5.5 metres further south
19	Kewbeach Avenue, between a point 7 metres east of Kippendavie Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east

On-street accessible parking spaces to be installed:

4	St. John's Road, south side, between a point 39.7 metres east of Runnymede Road and a point 5.5 metre further east
9	Salem Avenue, east side, between a point 16.8 metres south of Dupont Street and a point 5.5 metres further south

- 10 Wolseley Street, north side, between a point 25.9 metres east of Bathurst Street and a point 5.5 metres further east
- 11 Borden Street, east side, between a point 74.5 metres south of Ulster Street and a point 5.5 metres further south, from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive and from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
- 11 Borden Street, west side, between a point 71.5 metres south of Ulster Street and a point 5.5 metres further south, from the 16th day to the last day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
- 11 Euclid Avenue, east side, between a point 244.3 metres south of College Street and a point 5.5 metres further south, from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive, and from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
- 11 Euclid Avenue, west side, between a point 243.5 metres south of College Street and a point 5.5 metres further south, from the 16th day to the last day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
- 11 Manning Avenue, west side, between a point 85 metres north Harbord Street and a point 5.5 metres further north
- 14 Laing Street, east side, between a point 4.5 metres north of Memory Lane and a point 5.5 metres further north
- 19 Brenton Avenue, south side, between a point 11 metres west of Meighen Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west
- 19 Rosevear Avenue, south side, between a point 120.5 metres east of Dawes Road and a point 5.5 metres further east, during the months of May, July, September and November
