

## **Parking Amendments - Burrell Avenue**

### **SUMMARY**

---

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City Policy or by-laws.

Transportation Services is requesting approval to implement maximum one-hour parking on the north side of Burrell Avenue, between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily. This is in response to a request from local residents to provide on-street parking spaces for visitors to Gledhill Park, located at the southeast corner of Gledhill Avenue and Burrell Avenue.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect, at all times on the north side of Burrell Avenue, between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking for a maximum period of one hour from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., daily, on the north side of Burrell Avenue, between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue.
3. Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking from 6:00 p.m. of one day to 8:00 a.m. of the next following day, on the north side of Burrell Avenue, between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

All costs associated with the necessary signage installation are included within the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget.

## **DECISION HISTORY**

## **COMMENTS**

---

Councillor Brad Bradford on behalf of area residents, requested that Transportation Services review the feasibility of implementing maximum one-hour parking from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily on the north side of Burrell Avenue, between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue.

### **Existing Conditions**

Burrell Avenue, between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue is classified as a two-way east/west local road with a posted speed limit of 30 km/h. Municipal sidewalks are located on both sides of the road and the pavement width is approximately 7.3 metres. Heavy trucks are prohibited at all times. There is no TTC service provided on Burrell Avenue.

Gledhill Park is located on the south side of Burrell Avenue and east side of Gledhill Avenue.

The current parking regulations for Burrell Avenue are as follows:

### **North Side**

- No parking anytime between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue.

### **West Side**

- No parking anytime between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue.

It was pointed out by area residents of Gledhill Avenue that there is a considerable shortage of parking spaces around Gledhill Park. As such, Transportation Services staff investigated the feasibility of permitting parking on Burrell Avenue, between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue, to accommodate the area residents' request. Based on the area conditions and consultation with Councillor Bradford, there are no objections to allow parking for a maximum one hour on the north side of Burrell Avenue, between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue. Parking will revert back to no parking at all times outside of the one-hour parking restriction. This recommendation will provide eight on-street parking spaces to people visiting the Gledhill Park between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. daily.

A petition was signed by the local residents in support of the proposal to allow parking on the north side of Burrell Avenue, between Gledhill Avenue and King Edward Avenue.

Councillor Brad Bradford has been advised of the recommendations of this staff report.

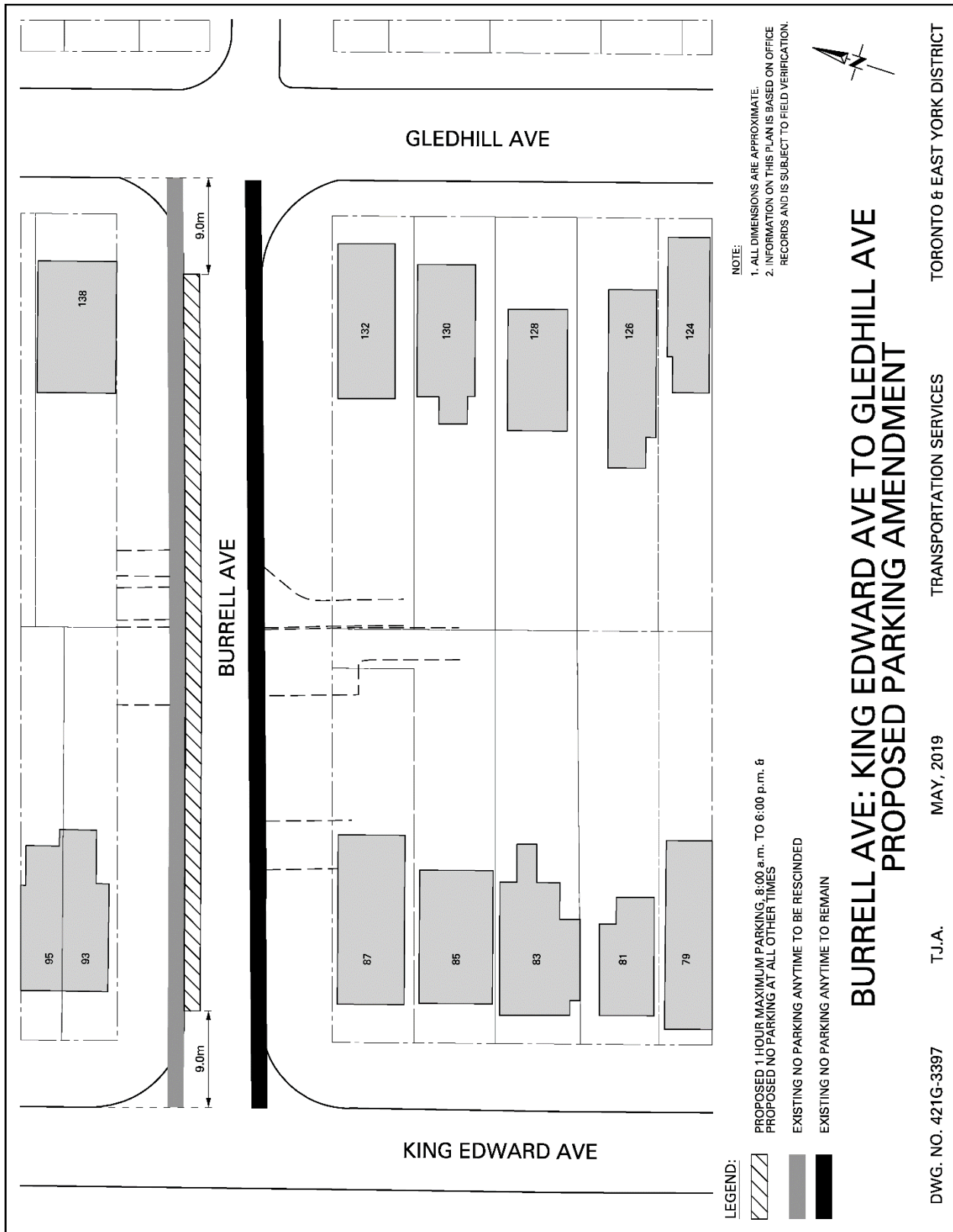
