

## **Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking – Rowanwood Avenue, between Yonge Street and Cluny Drive**

### **SUMMARY**

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This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Toronto and East York Council to introduce overnight on-street permit parking on Rowanwood Avenue, between Yonge Street and the south branch of Cluny Drive, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Rowanwood Avenue to accommodate their long term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement Officers.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

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The Manager, Permit and Enforcement, Parking, recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council approve the amendment of Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate the south side of Rowanwood Avenue, between Yonge Street and the south branch of Cluny Drive, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

2. Toronto and East York Community Council amend the parking prohibition in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Monday to Friday, on the south side of Rowanwood Avenue, between Yonge Street and Thornwood Road, to be in effect from Cluny Drive (south leg) to Thornwood Road.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

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The amount of \$400 is available within the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget.

## **DECISION HISTORY**

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A request was received from Councillor Mike Layton, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program on Rowanwood Avenue, to accommodate their long term parking needs.

## **COMMENTS**

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Rowanwood Avenue, between Yonge Street and the south branch of Cluny Drive, is a local roadway operating in a two-way east/westbound direction with a pavement width of 9.7 metres. There is no TTC service on Rowanwood Avenue.

Parking is permitted for a maximum one hour duration on the south side between 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday from a point 30.5 metres east of Yonge Street to the south branch of Cluny Drive. Parking is prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Monday to Friday from Yonge Street to Thornwood Road.

Parking is prohibited on the north side at all times.

Under the provisions of Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, we are required to conduct a poll of the residents to determine if there is support to introduce permit parking.

Ballots were mailed on August 8, 2019, with the last day for filing a response being September 6, 2016. The results of the poll are as follows:

The majority of area residents who returned their ballots are in favour of the introduction of overnight on-street permit parking on Rowanwood Avenue, between Yonge Street and the south branch of Cluny Drive

Transportation Services has no objections to the implementation of permit parking on Rowanwood Avenue, between Yonge Street and the south branch of Cluny Drive
