

Extension of Permit Parking Hours – Area 6K during the 2019 Christmas Market

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Toronto and East York Community Council to temporarily extend the overnight on-street permit parking hours of operation on the streets listed in "Appendix A" from their current hours to the new hours of 12:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m., 7 days a week during the 2019 Toronto Christmas Market, which takes place from November 14, 2019 to December 22, 2019, inclusive.

By extending the overnight on-street permit parking hours, residents will have improved parking flexibility during the Christmas Market, and the Parking Enforcement Unit, Toronto Police Service, can effectively control long-term parking by non-residents through tagging and towing operations.

RECOMMENDATION

The Manager, Permits and Enforcement, Infrastructure & Development Services, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council approve the extension of the overnight on-street permit parking hours on the streets listed in "Appendix A" of the report dated October 2, 2019 to the new hours of 12:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m., 7 days a week.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The amount of \$600 is available within the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

A request was received from Councillor Joe Cressy, on behalf of area residents, to extend the overnight on-street permit parking hours on streets within permit parking area 6K, to address concerns regarding the increase of non-resident parking during the annual Christmas Market.

COMMENTS

Having regard for the high level of demand for on-street parking generated during the annual Christmas Market, the temporary extension of the permit parking operating hours on roadways in the general area of the Christmas market as listed in the attached "Appendix A" will help maintain access to parking for existing residents with parking permits. Approval to extend the permit parking regulations on the streets listed in "Appendix A" is a delegated authority to Toronto and East York Community Council.

Transportation Services has no objections to extending the permit parking hours of operation to improve resident parking flexibility.
