The purpose of this letter is to request that **Tastemaker Toronto** be declared as an "Event of Municipal Significance".

Tastemaker Toronto is the evolution of Taste of Toronto, a vibrant food and drink event that celebrates culinary diversity, taking place at Toronto's Evergreen Brick Works located at 550 Bayview Avenue, Toronto from May 10-12, 2019 and November 15-17, 2019. The event is part of a newly-formed North American food and drink spectacle - the Tastemaker Tour. The Tastemaker Tour began in Toronto, May of 2018. Featuring four cities and close to a hundred culinary experts, the Tastemaker Tour is a celebration of cultural exchange, bringing together the hottest chefs, restaurants and master mixologists for the ultimate food and drink journey.

Locally, Tastemaker Toronto will serve as a platform to showcase Canada's culinary talents and artisanal purveyors, in an interactive environment that emphasizes sensory experiences.
