To Whom This May Concern,

On behalf of the Toronto Downtown Jazz Society (TDJ), presenters of the TD Toronto Jazz Festival, I am formally requesting declaration of the 33rd annual Toronto Jazz Festival, as a "special event of municipal significance".

This declaration will allow application to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission for a Special Occasion Permits to serve alcohol at three (3) festival locations between Friday June 21 through Sunday June 30, 2019. We are not requesting a liquor license extension of area, or hours.

- 1) BLOOR STREET WEST – NEW LOCATION
From the East side of the driveway exit at 150 Bloor Street West to St. Thomas Street. Licensed area will be a barricaded area on the street
Saturday June 22 at 12:01 am to Monday June 24 at 5 am
Serving hours 12Noon-11:00pm Saturday June 22 & Sunday June 23/19
- 2) CUMBERLAND STREET, between Bellair Street & Old York Lane
Barricaded area on the street
Friday June 21 – Sunday June 30
Serving hours 12Noon – 10:00pm
- 3) VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE PARK, 115 Cumberland Street
Barricaded area within the park
Friday June 21 – Sunday June 30
Serving hours Daily 12Noon - 10pm

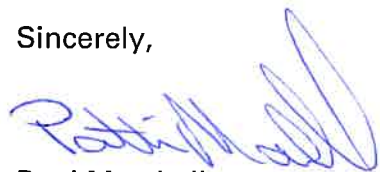
The primary purpose of TDJ is to present a world-class jazz festival to entertain local residents and visitors through performance, education and outreach and to make the music accessible to everyone by offering a wide variety of quality activities and musical styles. Since 1987 TDJ has presented over 3,400 free concerts, presented over 35,000 artists (85% of whom were Canadian), welcomed 12 million attendees and contributed more than \$600 million in economic benefits to the City of Toronto. The Festival draws over 500,000 people annually to performances at multiple indoor & outdoor venues.

The 2018 Festival generated \$41.1M in economic benefit and was ranked the #1 Music Event in Toronto by BizBash for the 2nd year in a row.
