**Re: TE5.72, Opposition to Residential On-Street Permit Parking in the Brule Neighbourhood**

The residents of the Brule Neighbourhood wish to register their strong opposition to on-street permit parking on Brule Gardens, Brule Crescent, Brule Terrace and Riverside Trail in Ward 4 (former Ward 13).

The enclosed Petition opposing on-street permit parking in the Brule Neighbourhood is signed by 118 residents, representing 73 households (80% of the households) in the Brule Neighbourhood. All residents contacted were strongly opposed to on-street permit parking. Some residents opted to voice their concerns directly with the City and Councillor Perks.

The reasons for opposing on-street permit parking in the Brule Neighbourhood are outlined in the petition. Most notably the reasons relate to:

- Lack of due process for residents of former Ward 13 that were intentionally excluded from the consultation and study process relating to the extension of on-street permit parking in former Wards 14, 18 – 22, 27 – 32.
- Safety concerns for residents and their families relating to the lack of sidewalks.
- Impact on services, such as emergency services, garbage, recycling and garden waste collection, snow removal and street cleaning.
- Concern that permit parking will change the stable and unique physical character of the Brule Neighbourhood, contrary to the Official Plan. Permit parking is not needed by the residents of the Brule Neighbourhood, who have wide lots, large driveways and garages. The Brule Neighbourhood is an enclosed enclave with limited traffic access.

On behalf of the Brule Neighbourhood, we are opposed to any potential policy changes and/or by-law amendments that would authorize on-street permit parking in the Brule Neighbourhood.
