SUMMARY:

A Rouge National Urban Park Welcome Centre as part of a Conservation Precinct in the vicinity of the Zoo is a shared vision of the Board of Management of the Toronto Zoo and Parks Canada. This report outlines the recommended steps for the immediate transfer of lands in the area of the Endangered Species Conservation Breeding facilities and Parking Lot #3 to the Rouge National Urban Park once the Tripartite Agreement is signed.
