FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$4,497,116 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$4,482,048 net of HST recoveries.

Funding is available in the 2020 Approved Capital Budget and the 2021-2029 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details follow in Table 1.
