\$3,845,054 net of all applicable taxes and charges
\$4,344,911 including HST and all applicable charges
\$3,912,727 net of HST recoveries

Contract is expected to start on the date of award and end on April 30, 2022

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$4,344,911 including all applicable taxes and charges. The total cost to the City is \$3,912,727 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$12,429,600 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2020 Approved Capital Budget and 2021-2029 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 as follows:

 - f. the Fair Wage Office confirms the recommended firm understands the Fair Wage Policy and Labour Trades requirements and has agreed to comply fully.
