The Aboriginal Affairs Advisory Committee recommends that:

1. In light of the COVID-19 emergency, City Council consider as part of the Housing Now Initiative, the dedication of sites for Indigenous housing projects, and the ownership of land to reflect the City's commitment to reconciliation and the commitment to support building capacity amongst Indigenous organizations and examine existing leases where Land or building ownership might be able to be transferred to Indigenous organizations.
