REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

This report is about labour relations or employee negotiations.

SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval for a bargaining mandate with IATSE Local 58 at the Meridian Arts Centre.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The President and Chief Executive recommends that the Board of Directors of TO Live:

1. Authorize the bargaining mandate with IATSE Local 58 at the Meridian Arts Centre, as noted in Confidential Attachment 1.
2. Direct that the confidential information contained in Confidential Attachment 1 remain confidential in its entirety, as it contains labour relations information or employee negotiations.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact other than those outlined in Confidential Attachment 1.

DECISION HISTORY

This is a new initiative.

COMMENTS

IATSE Local 58 provides stage labour services at the Meridian Arts Centre's venues; the George Weston Recital Hall, the Lyric Theatre, the Greenwin Theatre and the Studio Theatre. This is the second negotiation of the collective agreement since the amalgamation into TO Live. The Local works as a Hiring Hall. There is one house position in each of the four theatres and no guarantees under the current agreement.

The current collective agreement expires on December 31, 2020. Negotiations can begin with written notice as of October 3, 2020.
