

Parking Regulation Amendment - Windsor Street

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the east side of Windsor Street, between a point 15 metres south of Newcastle Street and a point 20 metres further south. The proposed removal is a result of a request from GO train commuters, forwarded by the Ward Councillor, to create additional parking on-street near the Mimico Station.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the east side of Windsor Street, between a point 15 metres south of Newcastle Street and a point 20 metres further south.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost of removing the "No Parking" signs on Windsor Street is approximately \$200.00. The funding for the removal of the signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2020 Interim Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services received a request from the Ward Councillor to rescind the existing "No Parking Anytime" regulation on the east side of Windsor Street to allow additional on-street parking up to the City-wide maximum of three hours. A map of the area is shown on Attachment 1.

Windsor Street is a two-lane local road located within the community east of Royal York Road, south of the F.G. Gardner Expressway and north of the Mimico GO Station. Sidewalks exist on the west side of the street in this area. Currently, parking is prohibited at all times on the west side of Windsor Street and from Newcastle Street to a point 35 metres south on the east side of the street.

In consultation with the Ward Councillor, Transportation Services recommends rescinding the "No Parking Anytime" regulation on the east side of Windsor Street, between a point 15 metres south of Newcastle Street and a point 20 metres further south to accommodate additional parking on-street. A 15 metre corner parking prohibition will be maintained on the east of Windsor Street, immediately south of Newcastle Street, for visibility and turning radii.
