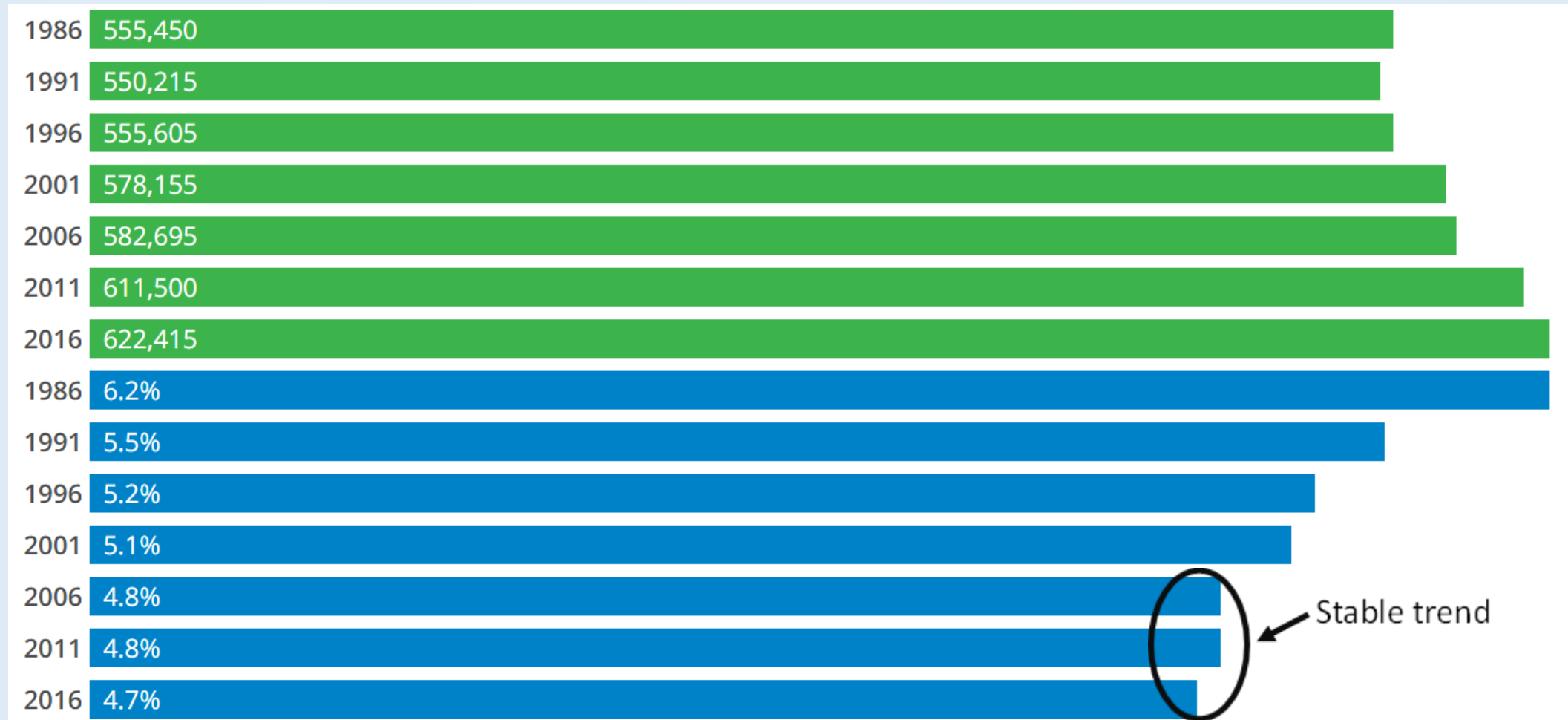

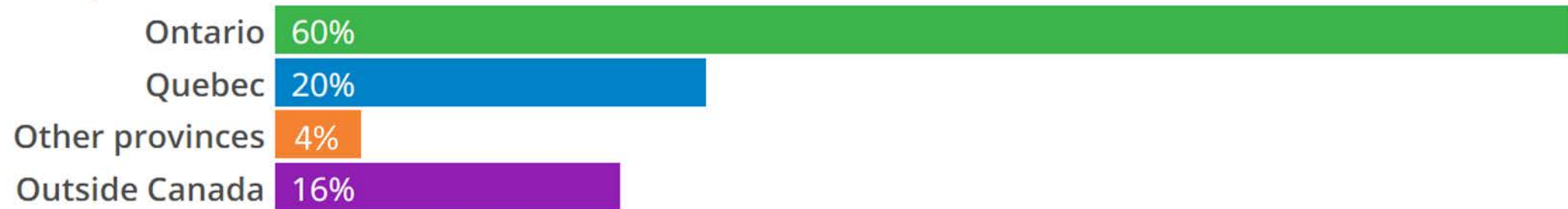

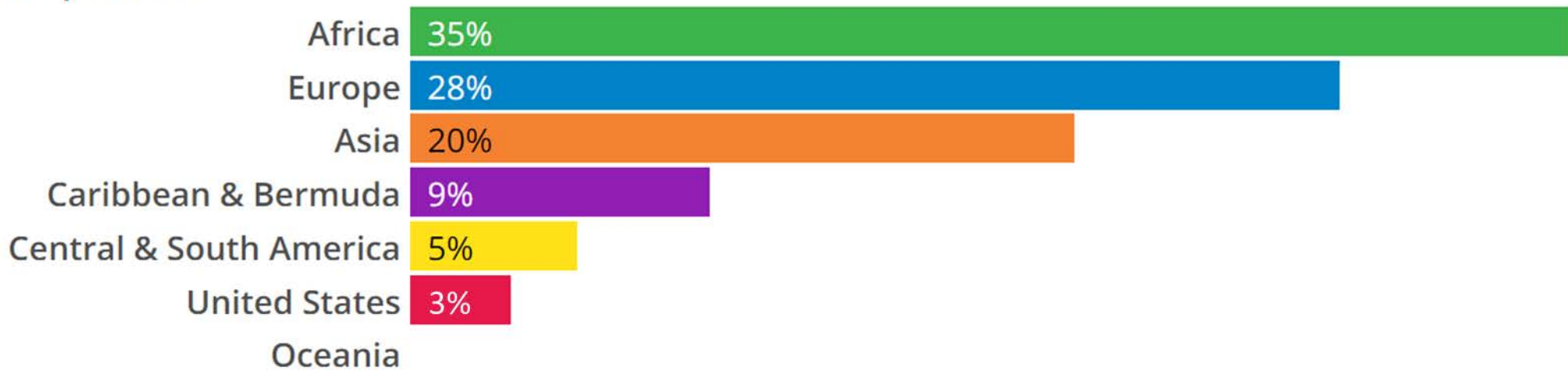

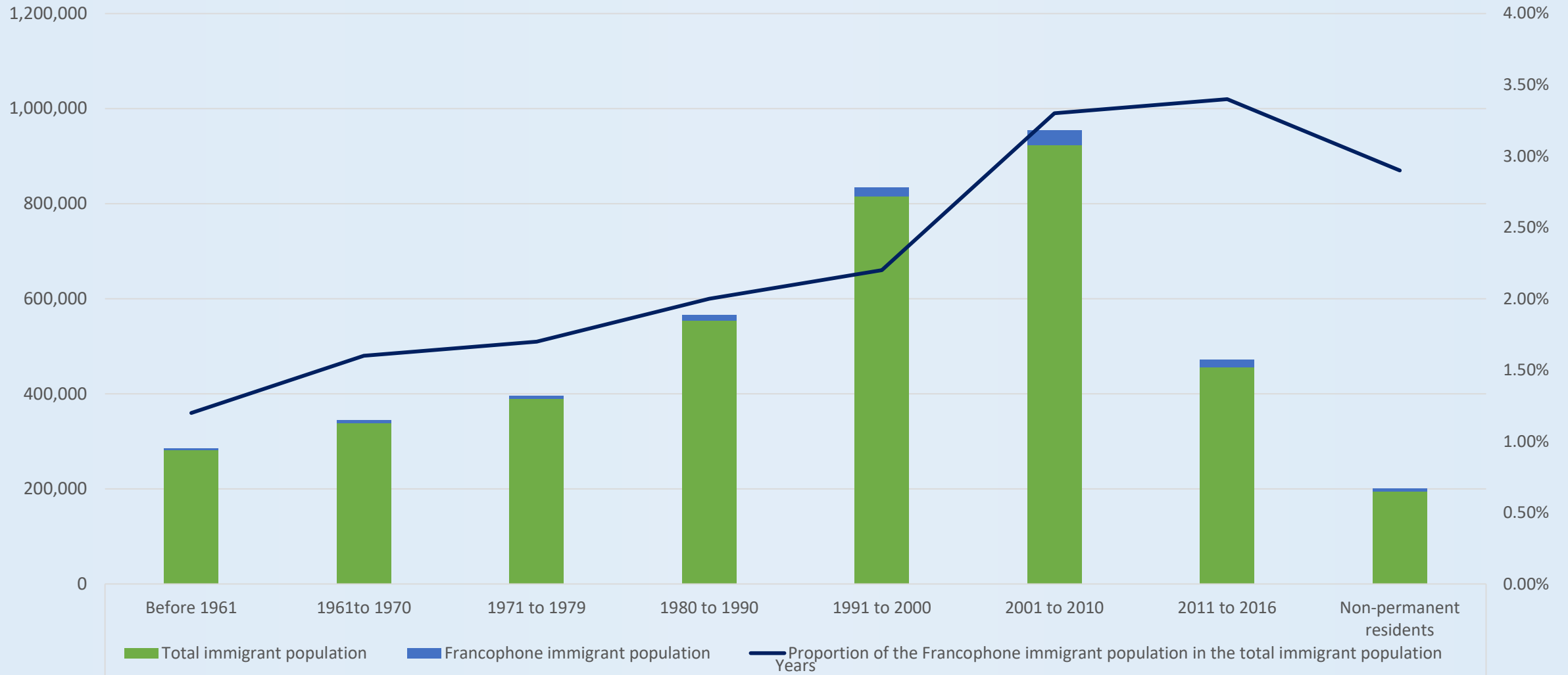


Place of birth of Francophones immigrants born outside Canada, 2016

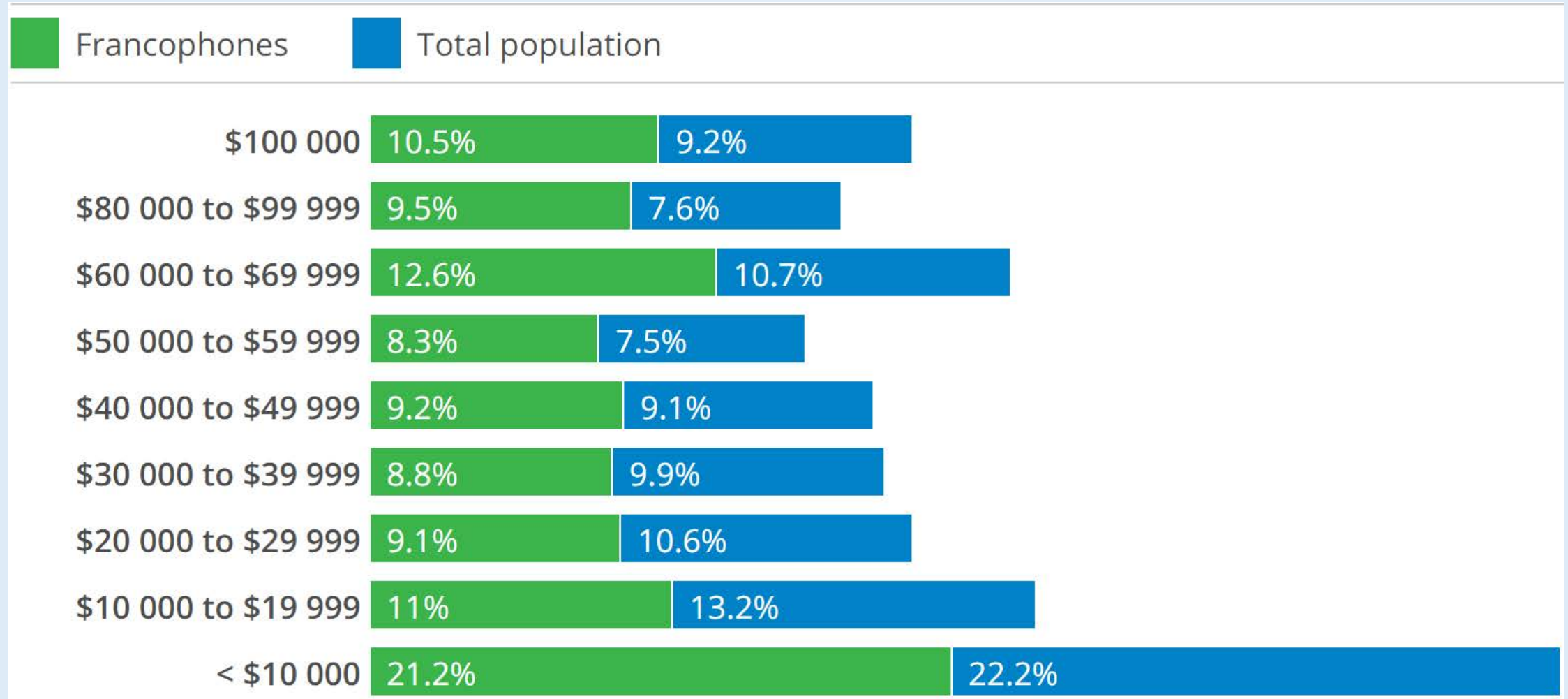

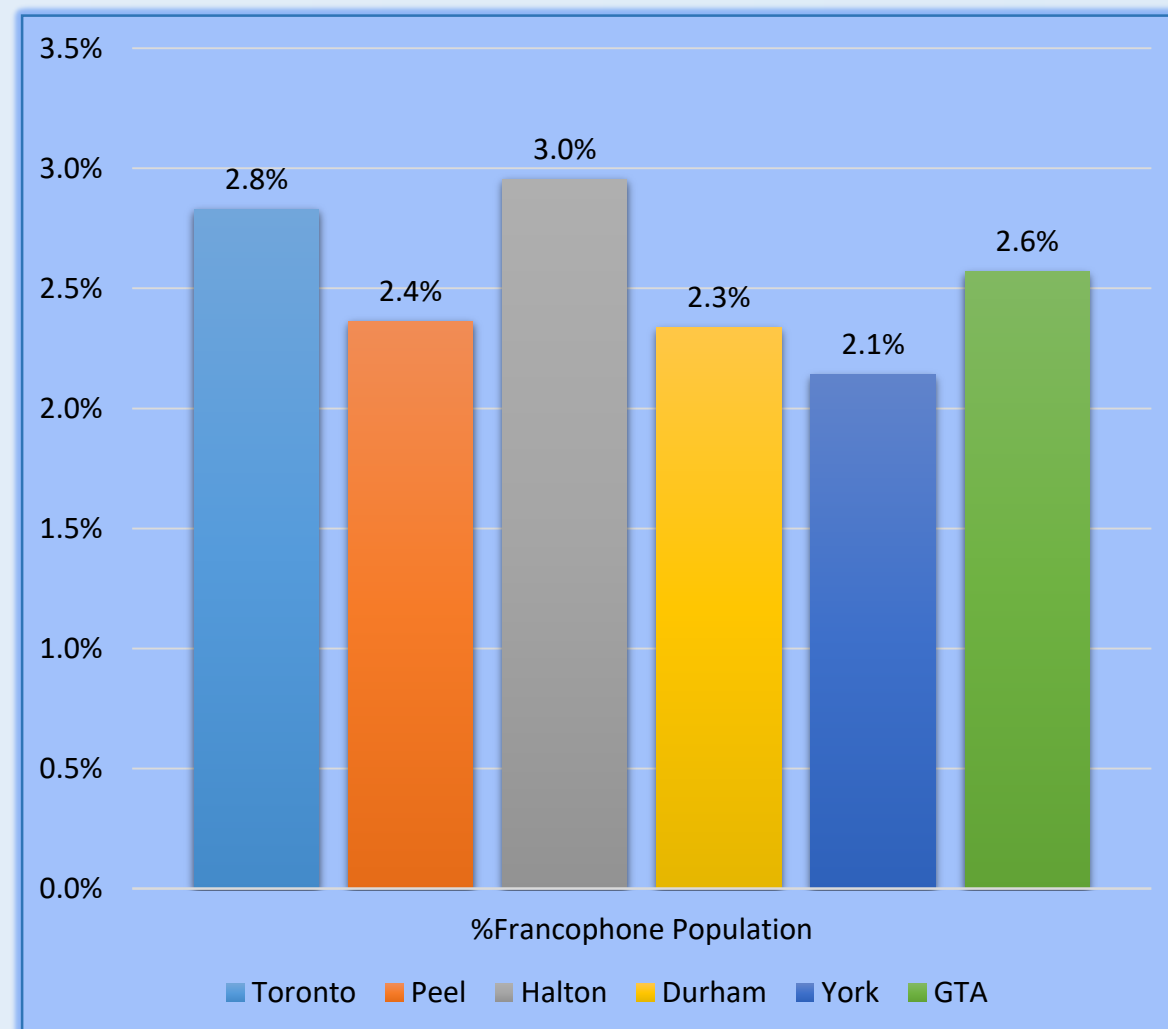

Employment income levels before taxes

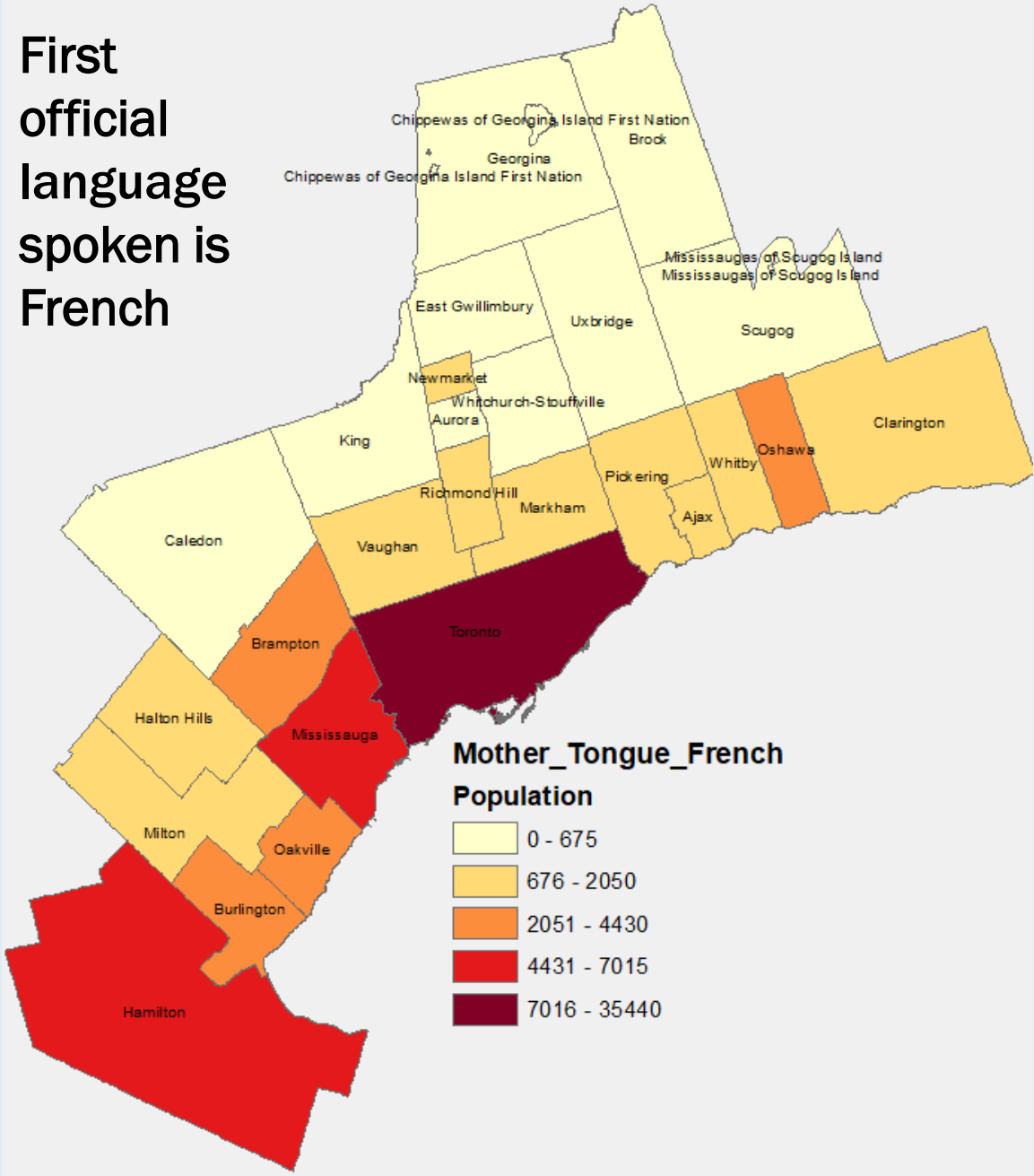

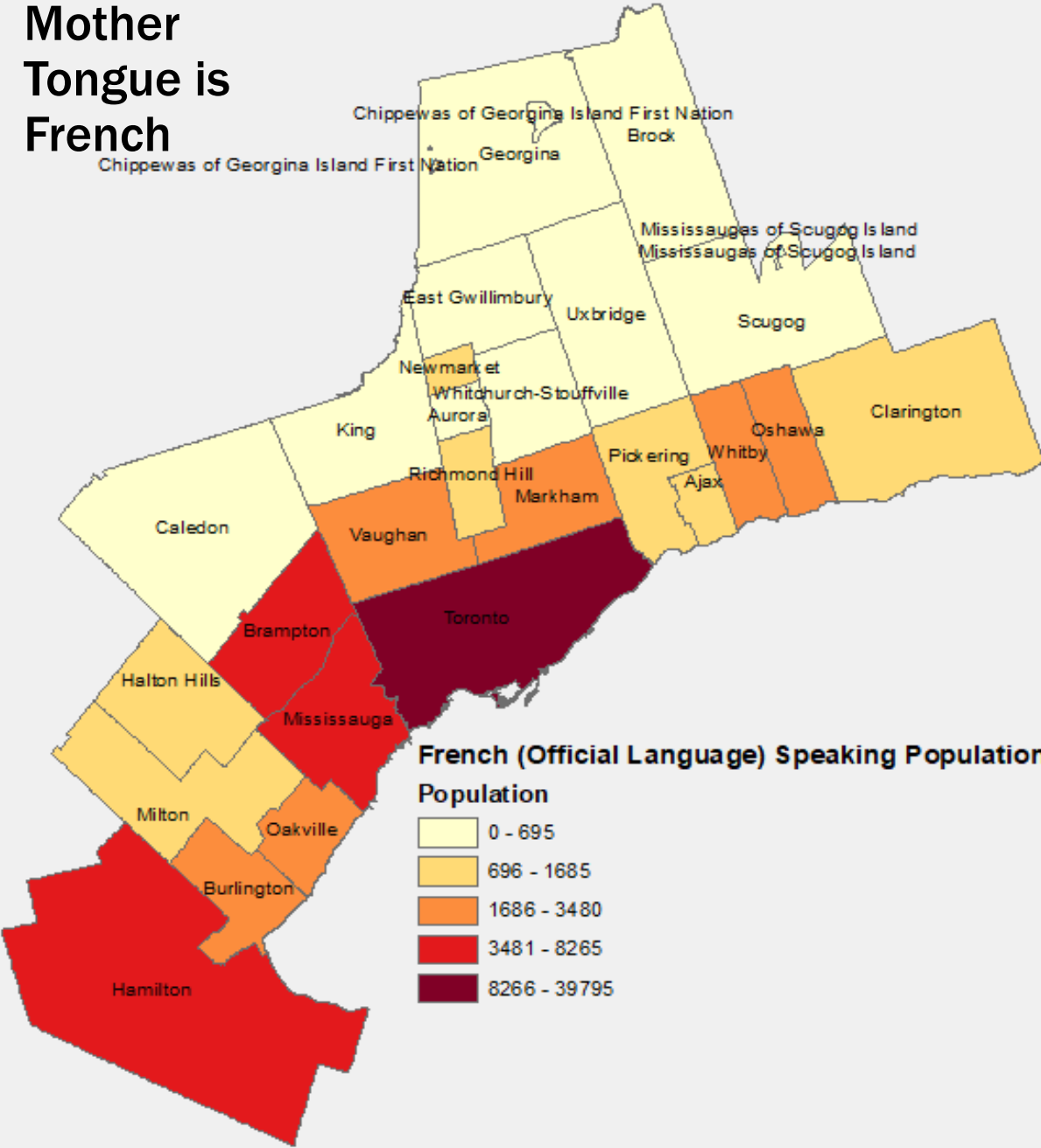

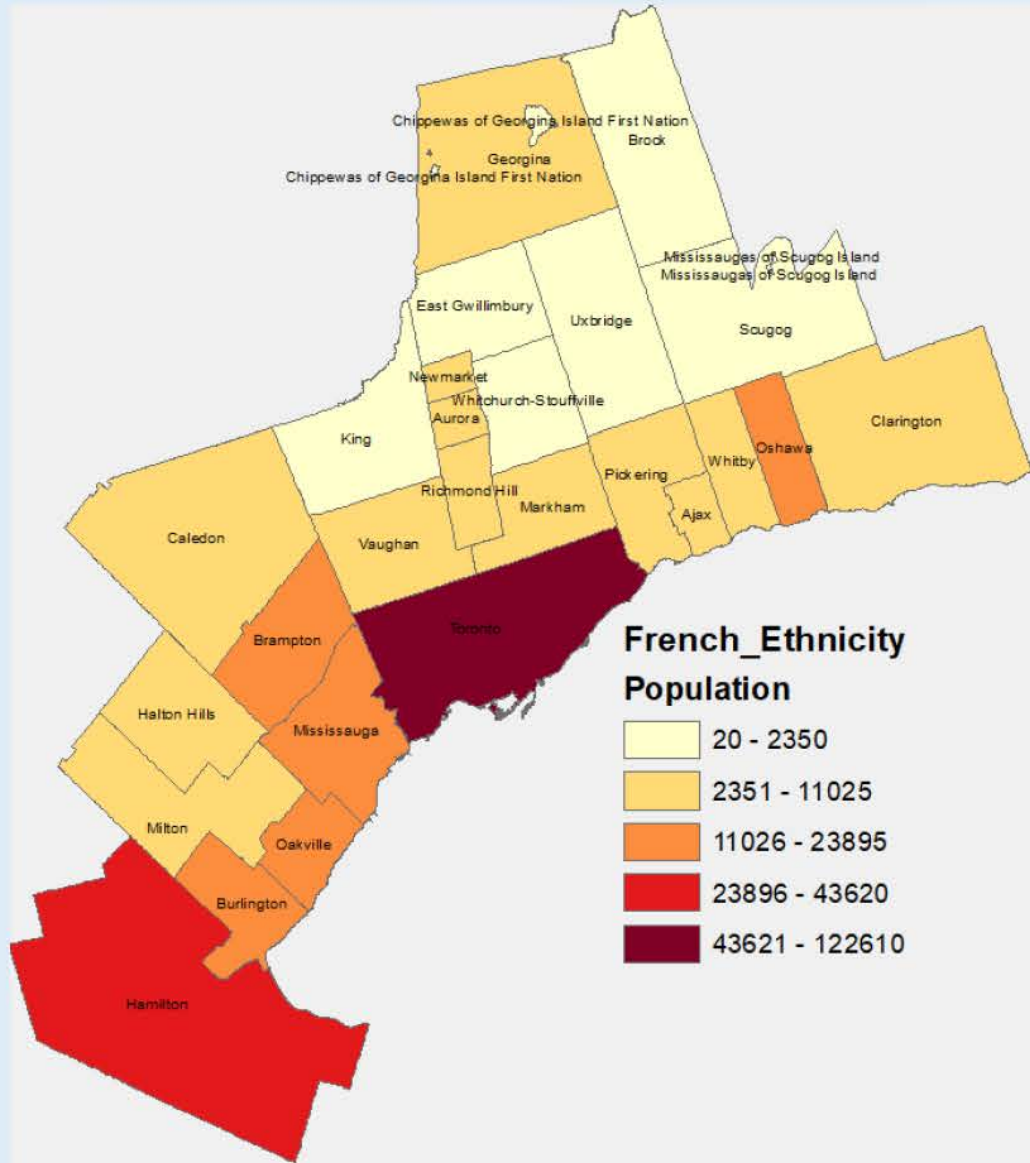

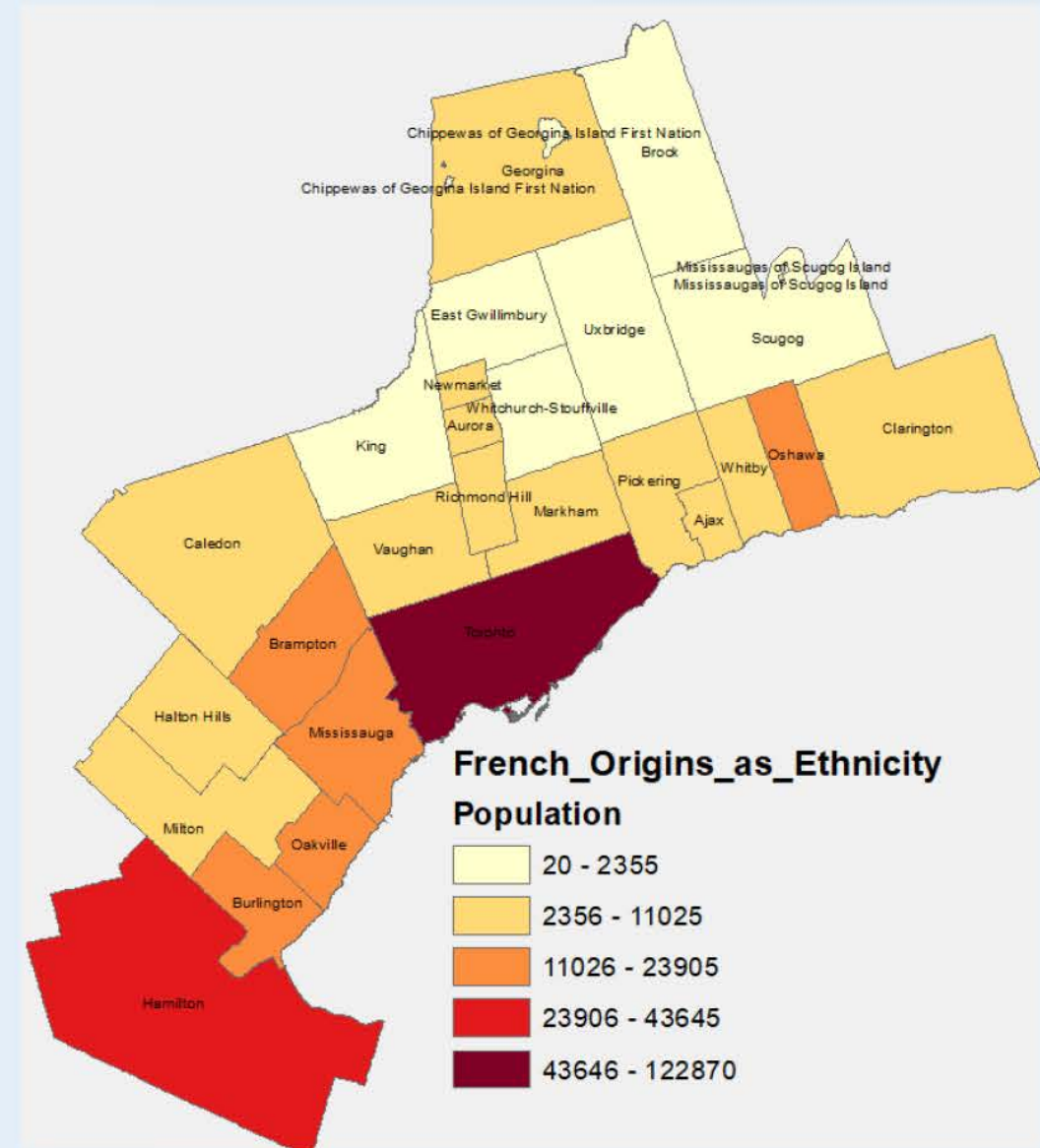
Mother Tongue is French



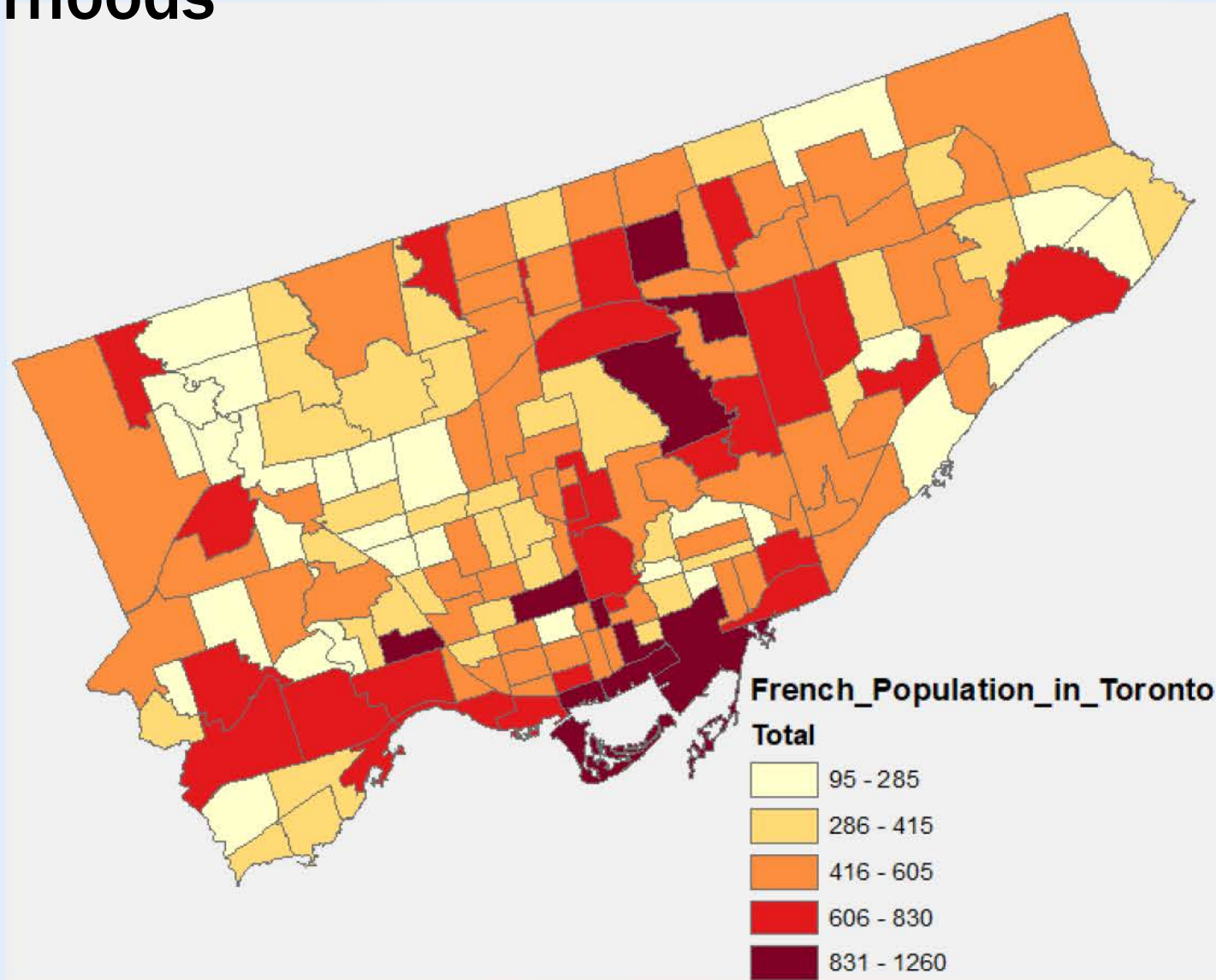
French Ethnicity



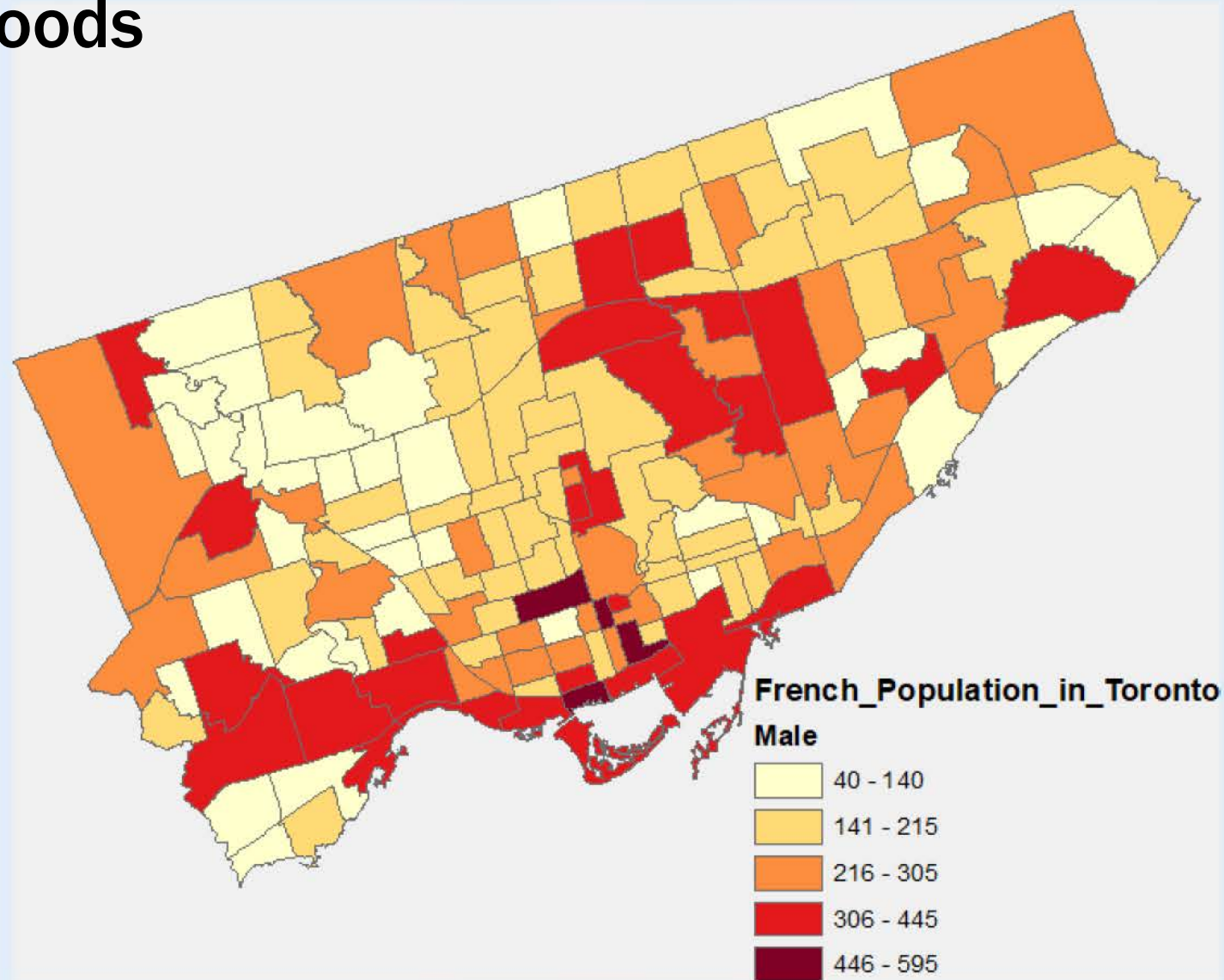
Ethnicity has French origins



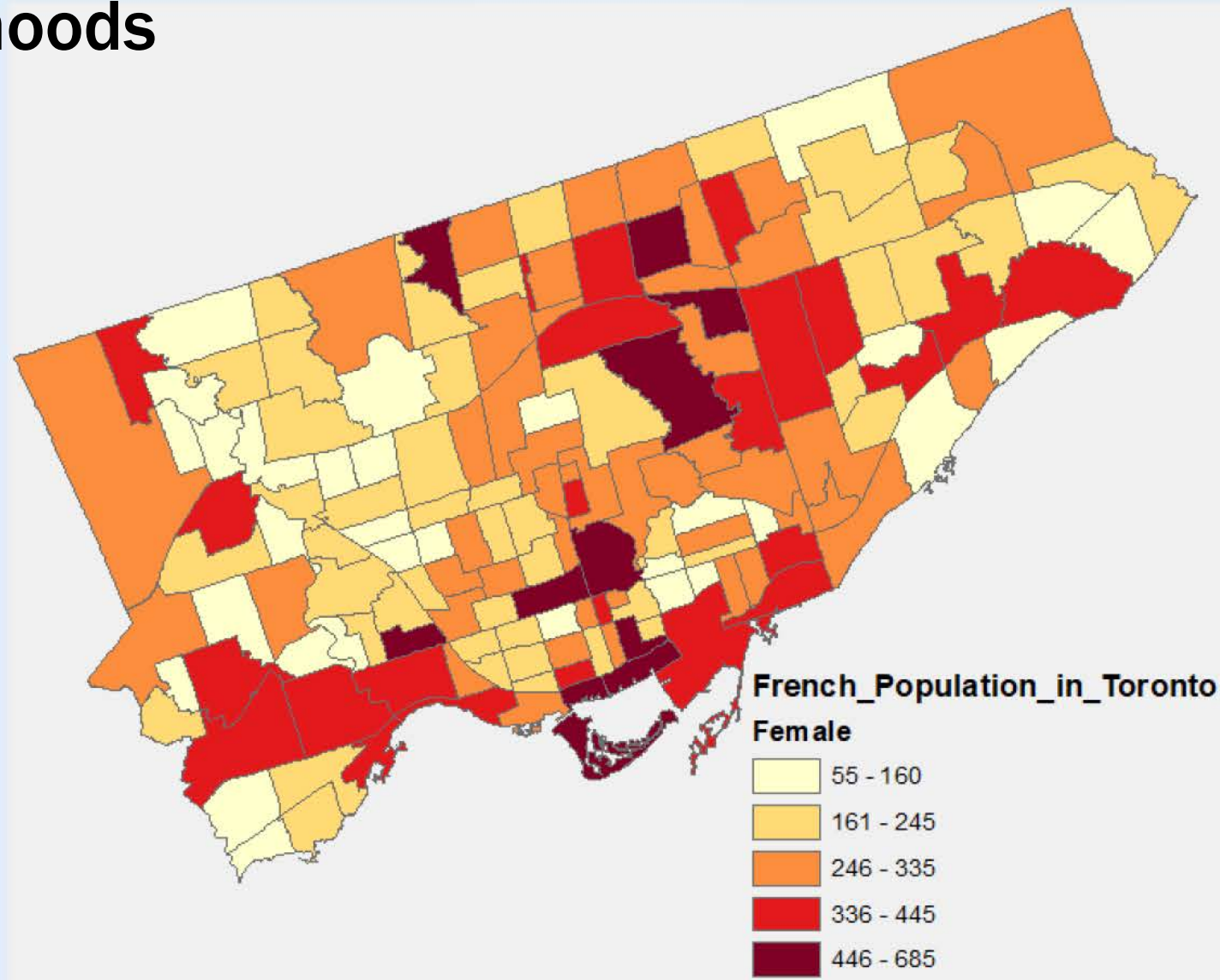

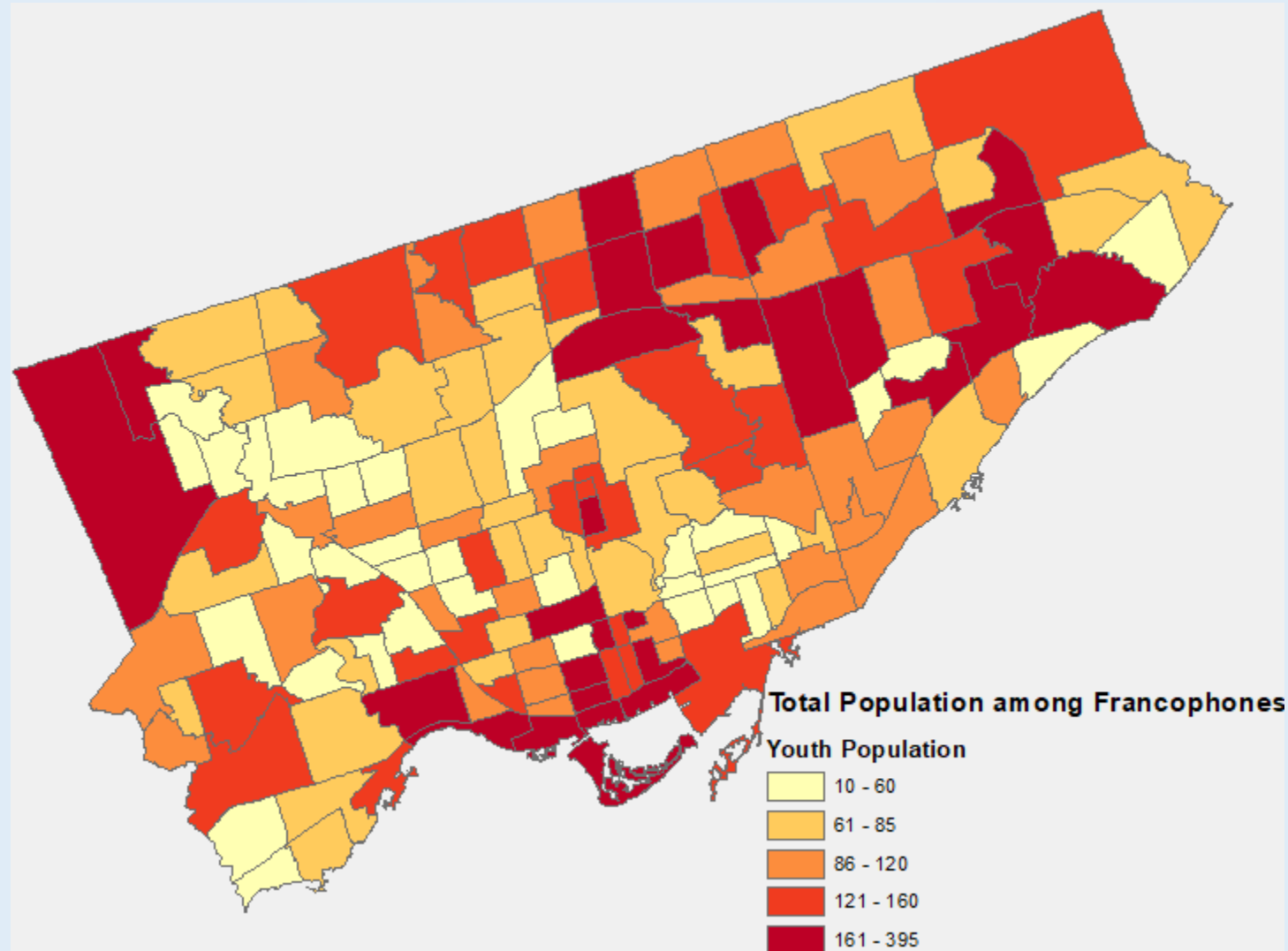
Francophone Males in Toronto: An overview of the Neighbourhoods



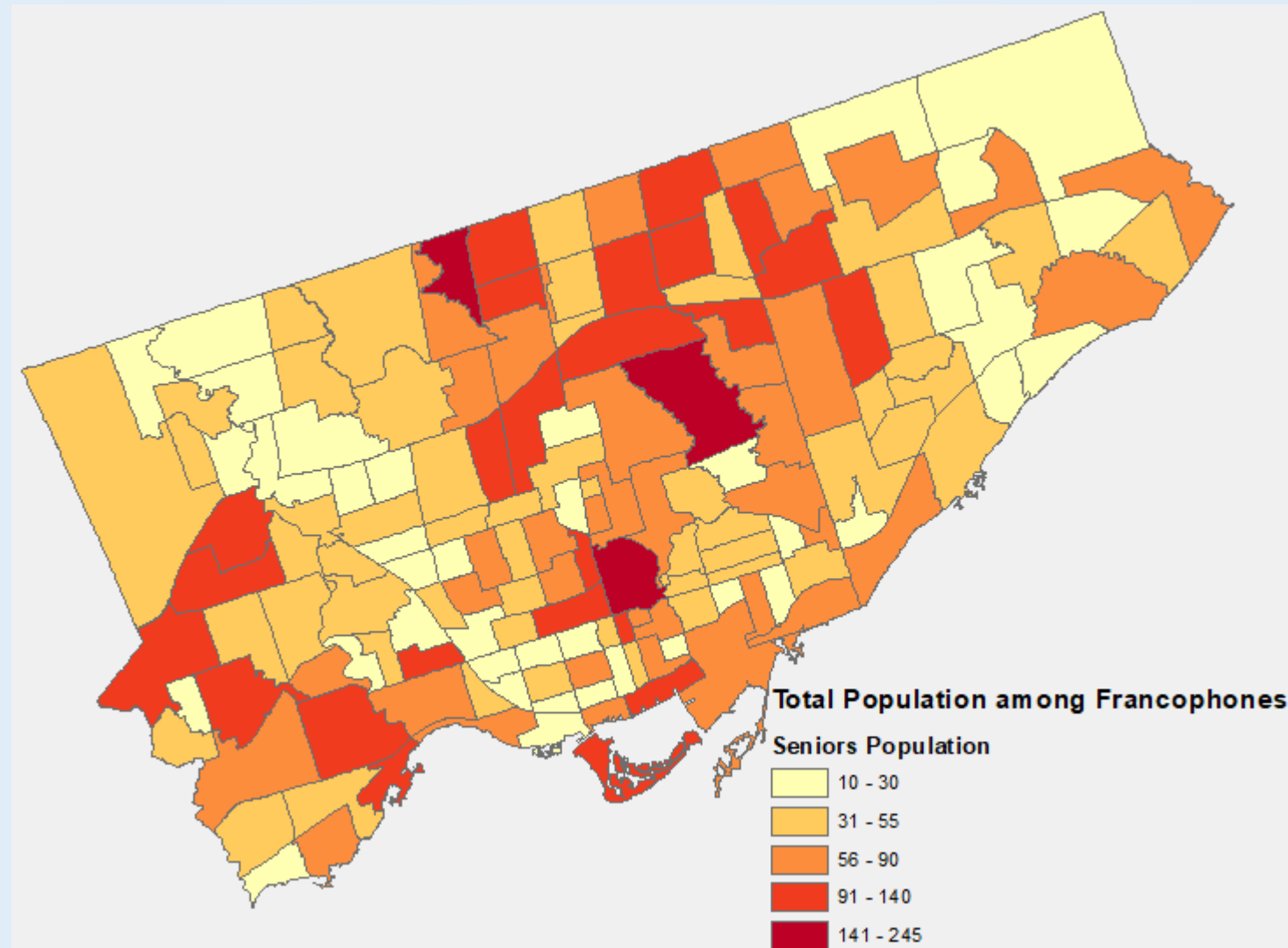

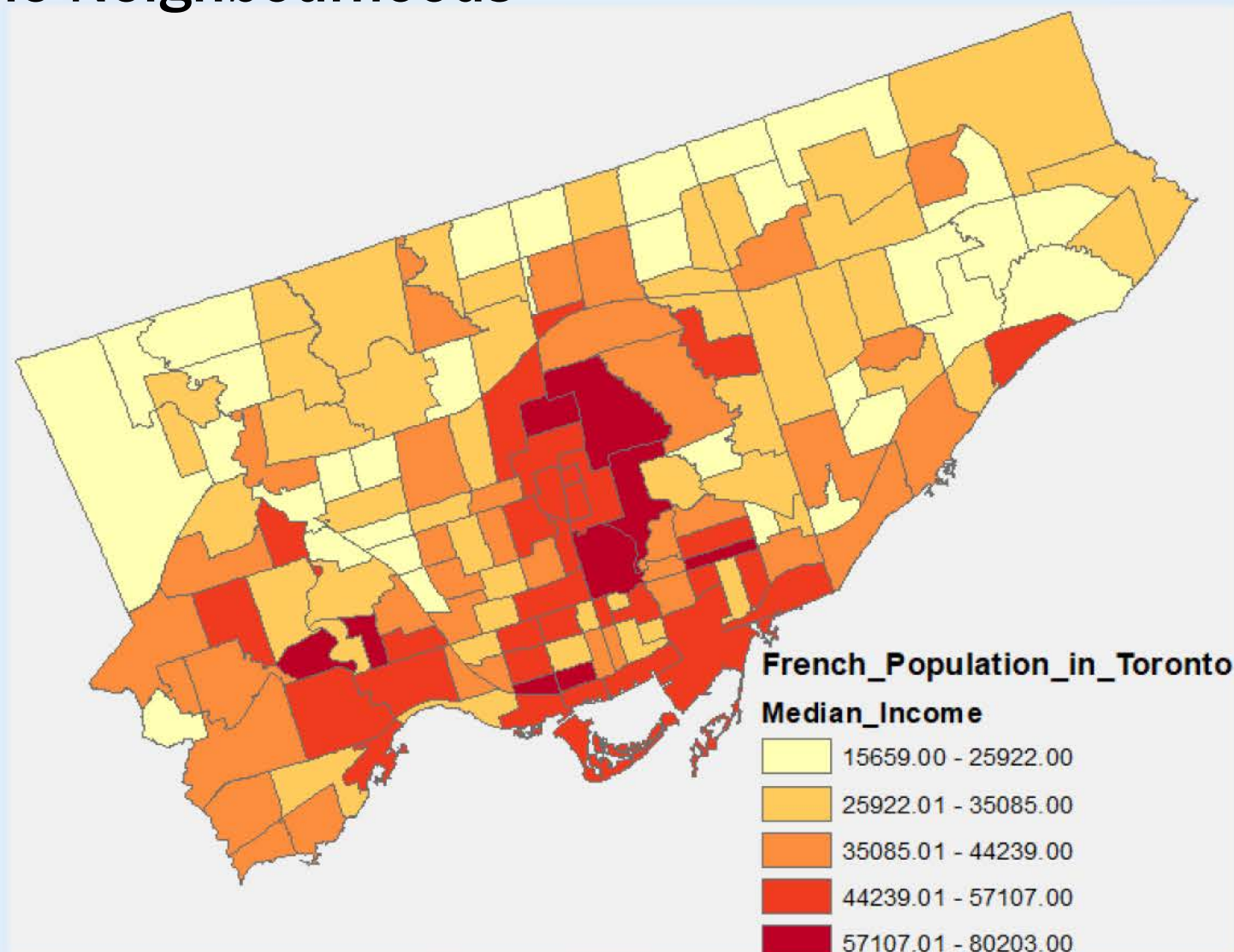

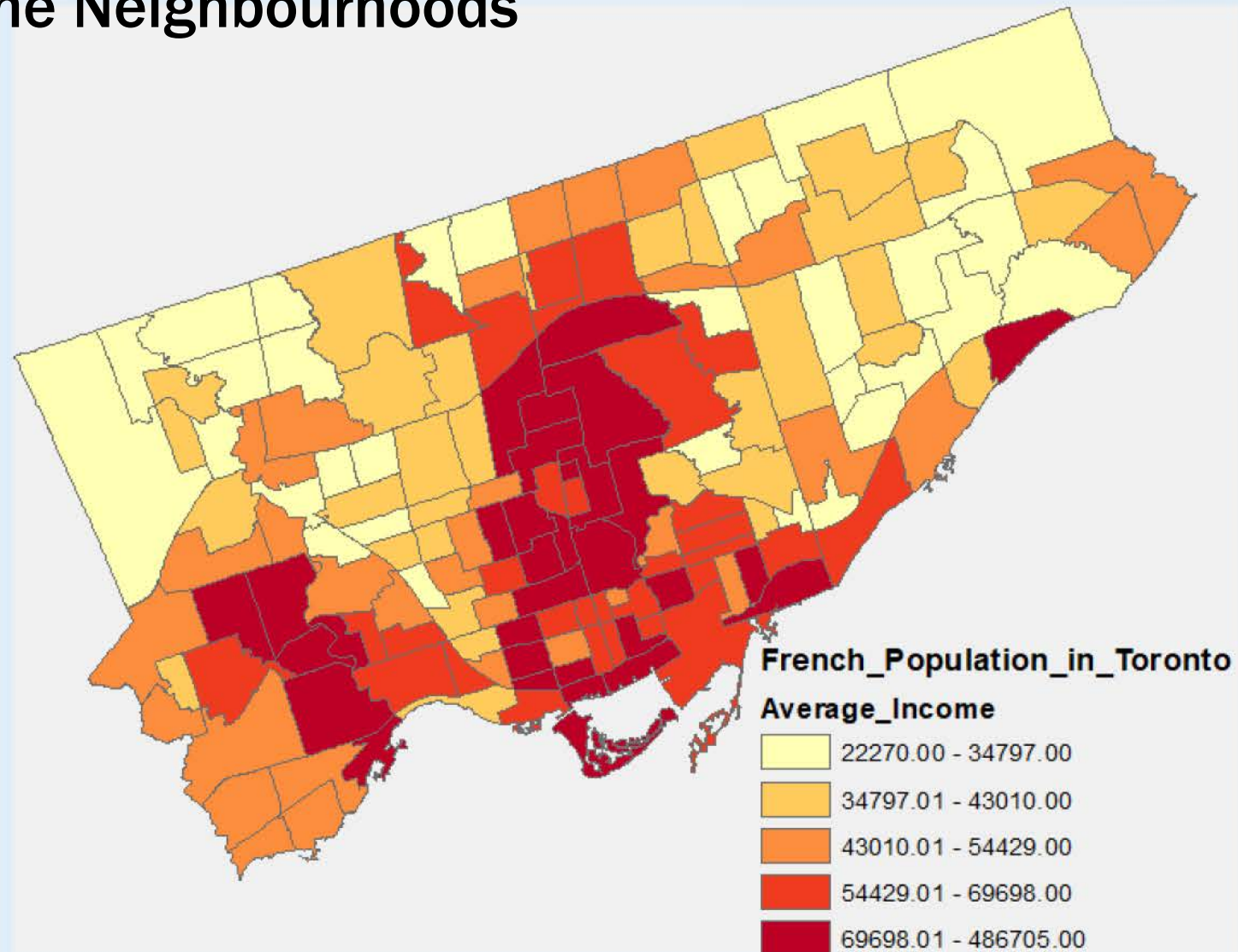

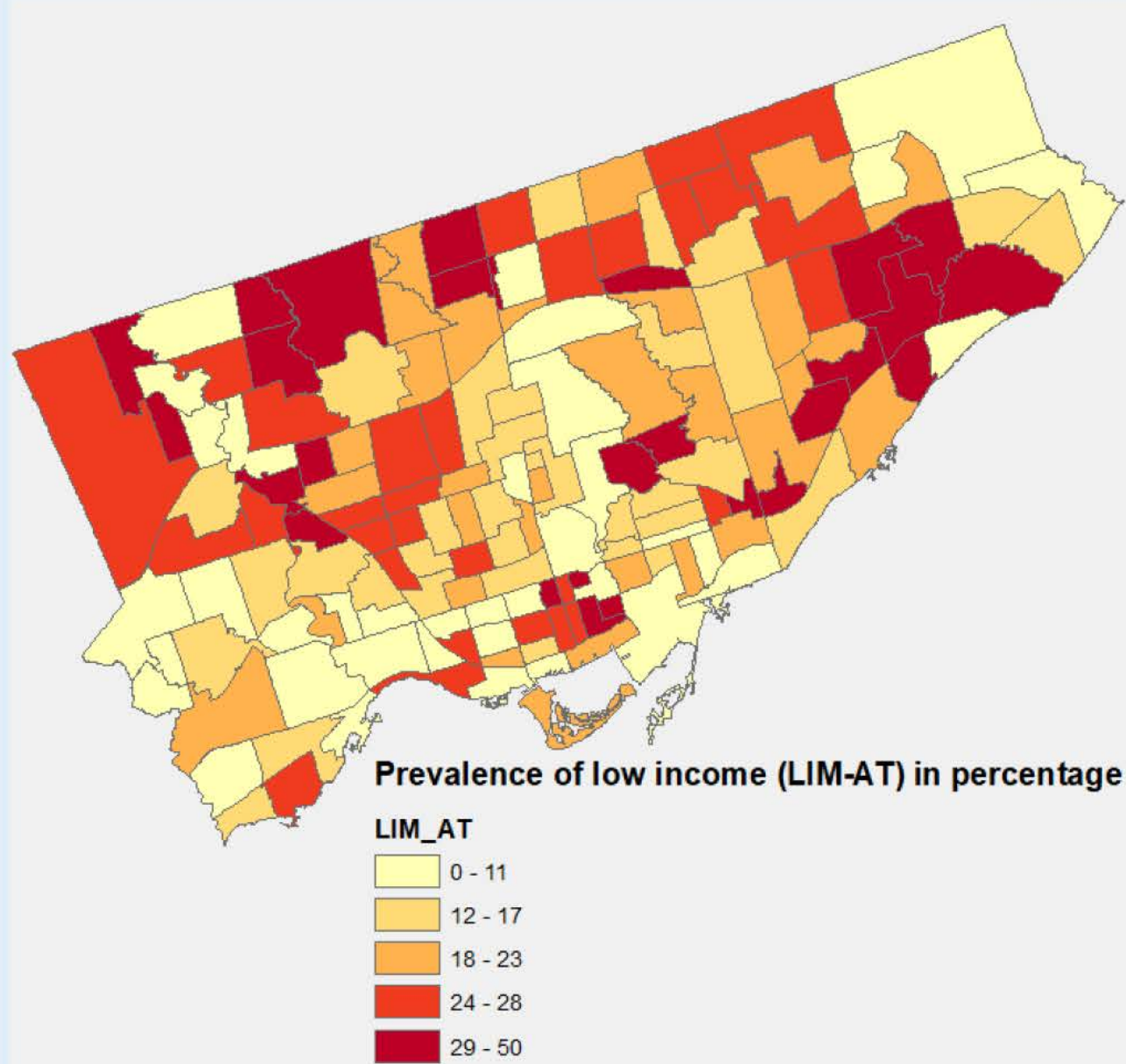
Median Income of Francophone Communities in Toronto: An overview of the Neighbourhoods



Average Income of Francophone Communities in Toronto: An overview of the Neighbourhoods



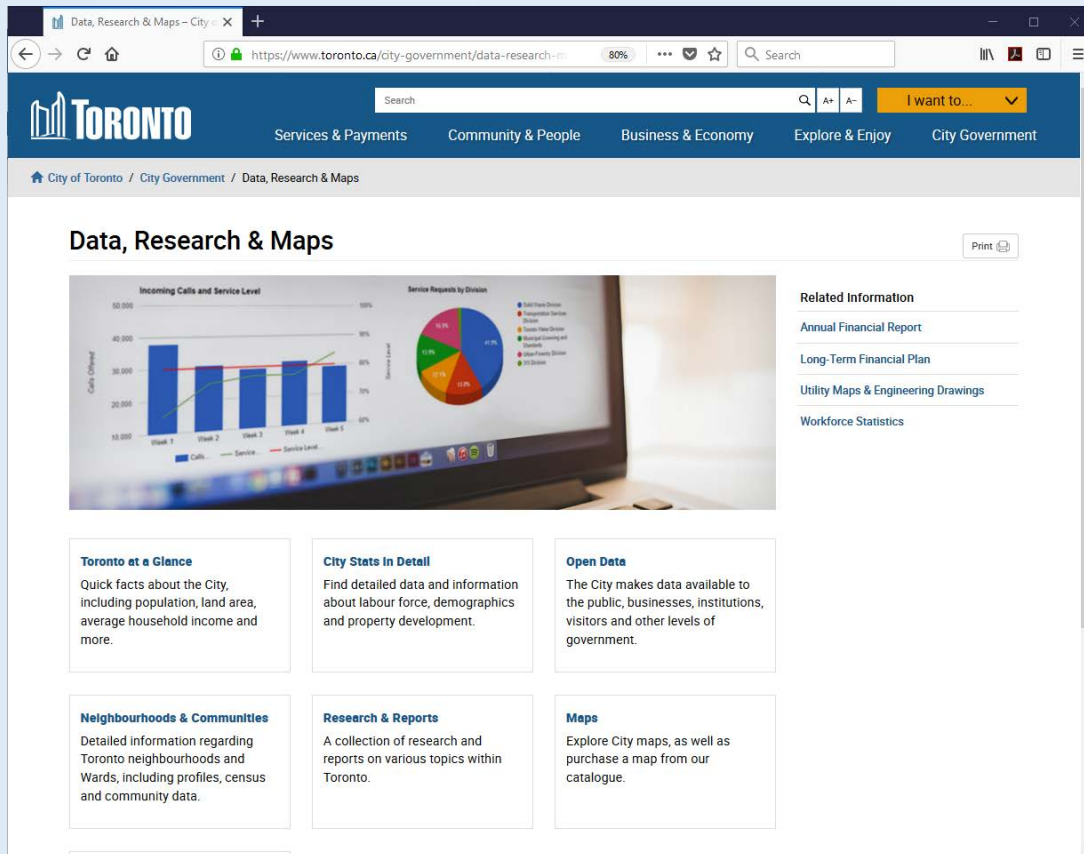
Prevalence of Low Income based on LIM-AT: An overview of the Neighbourhoods
