The Government of Ontario declared a provincial emergency on March 17, 2020 under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act. This declaration of emergency is currently in effect until June 30, 2020 and affects whether, or how, business and workplaces can operate.

Certain businesses and workplaces may re-open as long as they comply with strict public health measures and operate safely during the COVID-19 outbreak. The City of Toronto has released public guideline documents. The guidance documents are intended to support the City of Toronto, its businesses, and community organizations to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 transmission associated with their activities.
