

Accessible Parking Space - Roehampton Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

Transportation Services is requesting North York Community Council to authorize the installation of an accessible parking space on the south side of Roehampton Avenue.

The installation of the accessible parking space will address the needs of a local resident, while reducing the available on-street parking by one space.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. North York Community Council authorize the installation of the on-street accessible parking space on the south side of Roehampton Avenue, from a point 56.5 metres east of Rawlinson Avenue (east intersection) to a point 5.5 metres further east.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with the installation of the accessible parking space on Roehampton Avenue are included within the Transportation Services 2020 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services was requested by a resident of Roehampton Avenue to install an on-street accessible parking space on the south side of Roehampton Avenue. The resident is a tenant of a home where there is no available on-site parking included in the lease agreement.

Roehampton Avenue is an 8.5 metre wide two-way local road with sidewalks on both sides of the street. Parking is permitted for a maximum period of three hours on the south side of the roadway except from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. when parking is by permit only. There are a total of 39 on-street parking spaces available on Roehampton Avenue between Rawlinson Avenue (north intersection) and Banff Road. Currently 37 parking permits have been issued to residents for this section of roadway. Parking is prohibited at all times on the north side of Roehampton Avenue.

The applicant is a holder of a valid "Accessible Parking Permit" issued by the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario.

The proposed location of the on-street accessible parking space is on the south side of Roehampton Avenue, between a point 56.5 metres east of Rawlinson Avenue (north intersection) and a point 5.5 metres further east.

The installation of an on-street accessible parking space will not affect traffic flow on Roehampton Avenue.

In view of the above, Transportation Services supports the installation of the designated on-street accessible parking space.

The Ward Councillor is aware of the recommendations of this staff report.
