

Parking Prohibition - Addington Place

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting North York Community Council approve a parking prohibition in effect from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Friday and from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., Saturday and Sunday on both sides of Addington Place.

The proposed parking prohibition will help address the concerns regarding long-term parking and congestion in the area.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. North York Community Council prohibit parking from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Friday and from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., Saturday and Sunday on both sides of Addington Place, between Addington Avenue and the east end of Addington Place.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with installing the parking signs are included within the Transportation Services 2020 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services was requested by Councillor John Filion, on behalf of area residents, to prohibit parking from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Friday and from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., Saturday and Sunday on Addington Place, as long-term parking occurs on the street due to close proximity of the commercial businesses along Sheppard Avenue West.

Addington Place is 8.5 metre wide, two-way local street that runs east from Addington Avenue. It has a regulatory speed limit of 50 km/h and is approximately 70 metres long, which terminates in a cul-de-sac. There are sidewalks located on the north side of the street. Heavy vehicles are prohibited at all times and there is no TTC service provided on Addington Place. The land use in this area is single family detached residential.

Parking for a maximum period of three-hours (unsigned, statutory) is in effect on both sides of Addington Place. Additionally, the former City of North York's overnight winter parking by-law is in effect on this street.

Transportation Services staff reviewed the existing parking conditions on Addington Place. Staff observations, on February 7, 2020, revealed two vehicles parked on the south side of the street, with no vehicles parked on the north side of the street. To reduce long-term, daytime parking, we can support the parking prohibition from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Friday and from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., Saturday and Sunday on both sides of Addington Place. This amendment will help address residents' concerns regarding long-term parking from non-local motorists going to the commercial businesses along Sheppard Avenue West and parking for prolonged periods of time.

The Ward Councillor is aware of the recommendations of this staff report.
