

Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking – Old Orchard Grove, between Avenue Road and a point 208 metres east of Avenue Road

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from North York Community Council to introduce overnight on-street permit parking on Old Orchard Grove, between Avenue Road and a point 208 metres east of Avenue Road, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Old Orchard Grove to accommodate their long term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement Officers.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Manager, Permits and Enforcement, Parking, recommends that:

1. North York Community Council approve the amendment of Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate north side of Old Orchard Grove, between Avenue Road and a point 208 metres east of Avenue Road, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The amount of \$400 is available within the Transportation Services 2020 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

A request was received from Councillor Mike Colle, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program on Old Orchard Grove, between Avenue Road and a point 208 metres east of Avenue Road to provide consistent parking regulations throughout the block and to accommodate their long term parking needs.

COMMENTS

Old Orchard Grove, between Avenue Road and a point 208 metres east of Avenue Road, is a local roadway operating in a two-way east/westbound direction with a pavement width of 5.79 metres. There is no TTC service on Old Orchard Grove.

Parking is permitted for a maximum 1 hour duration from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., with the remaining times of day restricted to the 3 hour parking maximum on the north side of the street. Parking is prohibited on the south side at all times.

Under the provisions of Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, we are required to conduct a poll of the residents to determine if there is support to introduce permit parking.

Ballots were mailed on November 25, 2019, with the last day for filing a response being December 24, 2019. The results of the poll are as follows:

The majority of area residents who returned their ballots are in favour of the introduction of overnight on-street permit parking on Old Orchard Grove, between Avenue Road a point 208 metres east of Avenue Road.

Transportation Services has no objections to the implementation of permit parking on Old Orchard Grove.
