

Parking Amendments - Glen Park Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending the maximum 30-minute parking regulations in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on both sides of Glen Park Avenue, east of Dufferin Street, be amended to be in effect for a maximum period of one-hour during the same hours. The longer duration was requested by local businesses for their customers.

The proposed one-hour maximum parking regulations will address the concerns of local businesses and have a negligible effect on traffic operations.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. North York Community Council amend the existing maximum 30-minute parking regulation in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the south side of Glen Park Avenue, between a point 9 metres east of Dufferin Street and a point 36 metres further east, to be in effect for a maximum period of one hour.
2. North York Community Council amend the existing maximum 30-minute parking regulation in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the north side of Glen Park Avenue, between a point 9 metres east of Dufferin Street and a point 38 metres further east, to be in effect for a maximum period of one hour.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with changing the parking signs are included within the Transportation Services 2020 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

At its meeting of June 13, 2012, North York Community Council approved the removal of parking meters and approved the installation of parking for a maximum period of 30 minutes, on both sides of Glen Park Avenue, just east of Dufferin Street. The council decision can be found at:

COMMENTS

Transportation Services was requested by Councillor Mike Colle, on behalf of local businesses, to review the feasibility of extending the duration of the daytime maximum 30-minute parking regulation on both sides of Glen Park Avenue, just east of Dufferin Street. This was to address concerns that customers do not have enough time to have lunch.

Glen Park Avenue is an 11-metre wide, two-way local street with a 50 km/h speed limit at the intersection with Dufferin Street. The roadway narrows to 8.5 metres approximately 50 metres east of Dufferin Street.

The current parking regulations on Glen Park Avenue, between Dufferin Street and Capitol Avenue to the east, are as follows:

North side:

- Parking is allowed for a maximum of 30 minutes from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between a point 9 metres east of Dufferin Street and a point 38 metres further east;
- Parking is prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between a point 47 metres east of Dufferin Street and Capitol Avenue; and
- Three-hour maximum parking limit is in effect at all other times (unsigned, statutory).

South side:

- Parking is allowed for a maximum of 30 minutes from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between a point 9 metres east of Dufferin Street and a point 36 metres further east;
- Parking is prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between a point 45 metres east of Dufferin Street and Capitol Avenue; and
- Three-hour maximum parking limit is in effect at all other times (unsigned, statutory).

The proposed one-hour maximum parking regulation will address the concerns of local businesses and have a negligible effect on traffic operations.

The Ward Councillor is aware of the recommendations of this staff report.
