2020-02-01: Approval of Agenda

- PF moved to approve agenda. Carried.

2020-02-02: Approval of Minutes

- PF moved to approve minutes from January 20, 2020. Carried.

2020-02-03: Reports

2.3.1 Chair's Report:

- Chair reviewed TPB meeting of January 27. There was a presentation on the roles of public members on the Board. There are seven public members on TPB.
- Chair noted that alterations of Church street properties (#191, 193, 195 and 197) were not approved by TPB.
- Chair discussed issue of Community Preservation Panel for TO Core. He explained that a panel cannot exist outside of a community council.
- Regarding panel refresh, Chair suggested district meetings with community groups to network and bring up issues. Can also look for cultural heritage networks. AM suggested that panel members join stakeholder advisory groups of planning.
- Regarding promotion of heritage grants, PF was on jury as TPB representative. Over \$300,000 to be given out, mostly in our district and mostly for roofs and chimneys. PF noted that we should promote these grants on our website.

- JC suggested a refresh panel website. JC asked if we have the budget for this. AM still waiting on new budget. PF suggested more information on community plans and HCD studies on the website. JC asked panel members to provide her with additional suggestions.

2.5.1 Midtown

2.5.2 Downtown – PF

- 64 Wellesley St. LPAT hearing: PF noted that this property will be at LPAT in the summer. Much of the building to be demolished.

2.5.3 West – JC

- Parkdale Community Hub Project: JC noted that public meetings to be held on this Hub. Next phase includes heritage impact assessment. Hub being linked to West Queen West HCD and a focus on affordable housing.
- 'Ontario Line' subway: JC noted December feasibility study done by City.
- New development projects in Parkdale: 1488 Queen, 1372 Queen, Ontario Place: JC note meetings are coming up on Queen street properties. Regarding Ontario Place, Parkdale groups are concerned. Ontario Place For All Community Group put out new report. JC also noted March 5 meeting combining local groups and city planners to discuss neighbourhood changes in Parkdale.

- Barbers Lane: PB reported that will be petitioning 37 addresses soon.
