RE: PH17.8 – Lawrence Heights Phases 2 and 3 – Initial Development Proposal

Dear Committee Members,

Below is a list of suggested inclusions that need to be part of the future processes for the RFP and the Planning framework for Phases 2 and 3 of the Lawrence Heights Revitalization process.

- A Pandemic Covid-19 Protection Lens should be an integral part of all future design and built form of Phase2 and 3 of the Lawrence Heights Revitalization process that would include enhanced ventilation, indoor and outdoor hand washing and sanitation stations, enhanced open public spaces indoor and outdoor to properly deal with CVOID-19 related issues.
- 2. The building of the Community Centre Hub should be prioritized and constructed as soon as possible in the process.
- 3. The number of affordable units in Phases 2 and 3 should be increased substantially.
- 4. A "Rent to Own" pilot project should be considered for Phases 2 and 3 with priority for these rent to own units going to long-time residents.
- 5. Street-level retail should be incorporated into the build form.
- 6. Enhance density for market purposed build rental and condominiums should be accelerated as a means of underwriting costs of rental and subsidised units.
- 7. Stand-alone affordable Senior Buildings should be incorporated in the Phases 2 & 3.
- 8. A comprehensive safety and security build form needs to be included in Phases 2 and 3 to include some of the following enhanced safety: camera technology in public areas and streets; lighting on the main streets and throughout the public areas of the development; and other possible infrastructure to ensure safety and security of residents.
