They married after graduation and moved to Toronto when Paul received an opportunity to work for the City of Toronto. Eugenia worked for the Ontario Ministry of Housing.

Eugenia lived a happy life with her husband and their son, Stephen. One of the highlights of her life was travelling back to Lithuania for the first time for her 65th birthday.
