

Removal of Parking Prohibition - Sherry Road, between Manville Road and Sinnott Road

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision.

This report recommends rescinding the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north side of Sherry Road, between Manville Road and Sinnott Road. This was requested by Councillor Gary Crawford, on behalf of the surrounding automotive garages in order to allow their customers some temporary parking in front of their establishments.

RECOMMENDATION

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north side of Sherry Road, between Manville Road and Sinnott Road.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All cost associated with the necessary signage change are included within the Transportation Services 2020 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

As a result of a meeting at Don Montgomery Community Centre on June 7, 2019 with owners/operators of the 12 automotive garages on the north side of Sherry Road, Councillor Gary Crawford requested that Traffic Operations investigate the feasibility of allowing parking in front of the 22 establishments. Transportation has no objection to removing the existing parking prohibition on the north side of Sherry Road, between Manville Road and Sinnott Road.

Sherry Road is a collector road that operates two-way east-west traffic on a pavement width of about 10 metres. The regulatory speed limit is 50 km/h. Within the subject segment, heavy trucks are permitted at all times. The Toronto Transit Commission does not provide service on Sherry Road. Currently, the following parking regulations are signed within the east/west travel portion of Sherry Road between Warden Avenue and Sinnott Road:

North Side

- No parking anytime between Manville Road and Sinnott Road, and
- Maximum three-hour parking (statutory, unsigned), between Warden Avenue and Manville Road.

South Side

- No parking anytime between Warden Avenue and Sinnott Road.

Owners/operators of the 12 automotive garages on the north side of Sherry Road, between Manville Road and Sinnott Road, reported that customers were being fined when parked in front of their establishments. They requested the same parking regulations as the west part of Sherry Road, North Side, between Warden Avenue and Manville Road. This will allow their customers to park for short periods on-street in front of their garages.

Councillor Gary Crawford has been advised of the recommendation of this staff report.

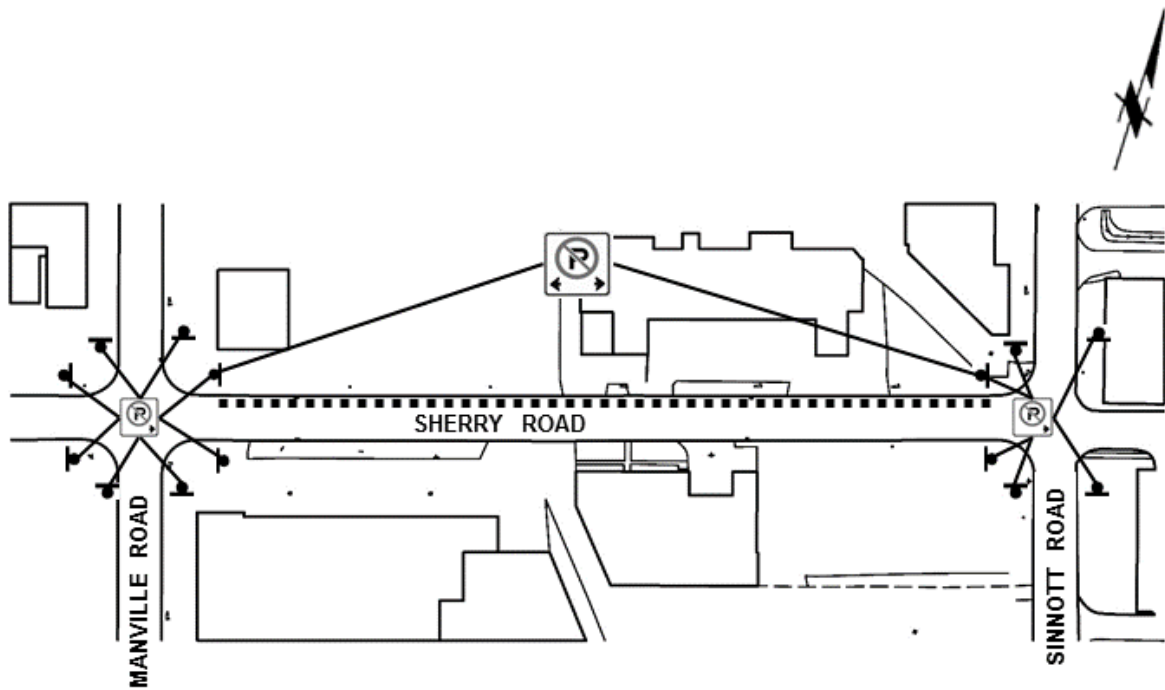
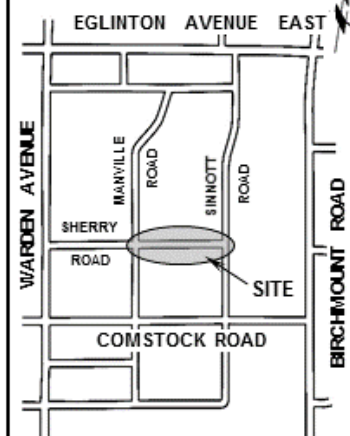
