### **Refusal of a Clothing Drop Box Location permit application located at 1967 Lawrence Avenue East.**

#### **SUMMARY**

---

The purpose of this report is to report on the refusal to issue a permit by Municipal Licensing & Standards in the matter of an application for a Clothing Drop Box Location permit at 1967 Lawrence Avenue East.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

The Director of Business Licensing and Regulatory Services, Municipal Licensing & Standards recommends that:

1. City Council deny the application for the proposed Clothing Drop Box Location permit at 1967 Lawrence Avenue East.

## **DECISION HISTORY**

---

This is a new application for a clothing drop box permit located at 1967 Lawrence Avenue East.

## **COMMENTS**

---

An application for clothing drop box permit at 1967 Lawrence Avenue East was received on February 4, 2020 from the business owner representing AMJ Recycling Inc. operating as AMJ Recycling Inc. The application submitted was seeking permission to place/install a clothing drop box. (Appendix No. 1 and 2)

This application meets the physical criteria for a clothing drop box location permit, as set out in Chapter 395 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.

The City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 395-2, Subsection B.(1)(a) states: Where a written objection is received by the Executive Director within the fourteen day period in Subsection B(1)(a), the Executive Director shall refuse the application, notify the applicant of the refusal of the application and advise the applicant that the applicant may, within 30 days of the date of the refusal, appeal the refusal to the Executive Director in writing.

An objection from the Ward Councillor was received by Municipal Licensing & Standards on February 5, 2020.

A refusal letter was sent on February 5, 2020 to the business owner, advising the applicant that an objection was received by the local Councillor and that the clothing drop box location permit application was denied.

On February 12, 2020 a letter was received by Municipal Licensing & Standards from the business owner, to appeal the decision of the denial for a clothing drop box location permit.
