

Compulsory Stop Control - McMillan Avenue and Fergalea Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services recommends stop control for the minor street at the uncontrolled three-way intersection of McMillan Avenue and Fergalea Avenue in order to clearly define the right-of-way and to regulate traffic flow.

RECOMMENDATION

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council authorize compulsory stop control for northbound traffic on McMillan Avenue at Fergalea Avenue.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost of installing the required sign is approximately \$250. Funding for the sign is available in the Transportation Services 2020 Interim Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

As a result of an operational review, Transportation Services staff identified an uncontrolled three-way intersection at McMillan Avenue and Fergalea Avenue.

Existing Conditions

The following characteristics describe McMillan Avenue and Fergalea Avenue:

- The uncontrolled three-way intersection is located north of Lawrence Avenue East, south of Kingston Road, and west of Meadowvale Road.
- There are no sidewalks located on both streets.
- The land use in this area is single family residential dwellings.

A minor street stop sign is recommended at the uncontrolled three-way "T" type intersection. This will provide stop sign uniformity on the streets in this area, clearly define the right-of-way, and enhance driver and pedestrian safety.
