Dear Scarborough Community Council,

William G. Davis Junior Public School is located at 128 East Avenue in the City of Toronto. The school sits precisely in the middle of the two proposed all-way stops that Councillor McKelvie is seeking by way of item 2020.SC18.11. We are writing today on behalf of Davis Parent Council, which is located at the same address.

By way of these comments, Davis Parent Council wishes to communicate our unwavering support of Councillor McKelvie's motion and hope that Scarborough Community Council will vote to approve it. We agree with all of Councillor McKelvie's comments in her motion materials. We sincerely appreciate Councillor McKelvie bringing this important motion forward for Council's consideration.

East Avenue, particularly the area near the school, is known to be unsafe for children and pedestrians during school drop-off and pick-up. This is particularly so given the proximity of the school to the Rouge Hill Go Station and that East Avenue empties into the Go Train parking lot. It is a highly used road by commuters rushing to the Go Train or from the Go Train home during rush hour – which unfortunately coincides with school pick-up and drop-off times. Davis Parent Council is confident that the installation of the all-way stops will have a positive impact on road safety on East Avenue and again ask Scarborough Community Council approve it.
