


Why TAF does climate policy* work

- To achieve our mandate: carbon reductions in the GTHA
- Because smart policy and removing policy barriers
 - delivers predictable carbon reduction
 - helps scale/commercialize low-carbon solutions and best practices
 - is a cost-effective urban carbon reduction tool

* Policy = legislation, regulation, budgets and other tools that establish requirements

How we work

- Compliance with all regulatory, governance and financial requirements; TAF/City Relationship Framework includes "to act as an advocate with other orders of government"

- Firmly focused on carbon reductions.

What we are working on

Featured example: Green Development Standards (GDS)

- History: TAF's Green Condo loan proved building better than code was cost effective and created Industry champions for Toronto Green Standard (TGS) adopted in 2010
- TAF and City of Toronto worked together to develop and advance adoption of TGS versions 2 (2014) and 3 (2018)
- TGS is the single biggest measure in the TransformTO climate plan.
- Next steps advocating and supporting adoption of Now working on GDSs by other GTHA municipalities.






Example of Policy Work: Town of Whitby Green Development Standard
