

Installation/Removal of On-Street Accessible Parking Spaces – December 2019 (Delegated)

SUMMARY

This staff report concerns a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision. The purpose is to obtain authorization for the installation/removal of a number of on-street accessible parking spaces.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces at the locations identified in Appendix A attached to the report dated December 10, 2019 from the Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funds in the estimated amount of \$3,600.00 are included within the Transportation Services Division's 2020 Interim Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses an ongoing initiative.

The Transportation Services Division receives a number of requests for the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces for persons with disabilities. Some of these requests come directly from members of the public and others are received through the local Councillors' offices.

Designated on-street accessible parking spaces are provided for people with disabilities and/or those who transport them, making it easier for them to find available parking as near as possible to their places of residence or intended destinations and reducing the distances that disabled people must walk. Delays in installing these on-street accessible spaces may create hardships for disabled applicants.

Timely removal of designated on-street accessible parking spaces when these spaces are no longer required is necessary in order to maximize available on-street parking for other residents/motorists.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services staff have investigated the feasibility of installing/removing on-street accessible parking spaces at the locations identified in Appendix A included in this report. None of these sections of roadway are served by TTC transit routes.

For locations where on-street accessible parking spaces are being established, all applicants are holders of valid Accessible Parking Permits issued by the Ministry of Transportation and each designated space will not result in the loss of more than one on-street parking space for general use. Locations where on-street accessible parking spaces are being removed are the result of applicants moving, holding expired permits or no longer requiring these on-street parking spaces. In certain instances, existing accessible parking spaces may be relocated for technical or operational reasons.

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Appendix A

On-street accessible parking spaces to be removed:

Ward	Location
19	Gledhill Avenue, east side, between a point 74 metres north of King Edward Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north, during the months of January, February, March, April, June, August, October and December
19	Gledhill Avenue, west side, between a point 70 metres north of King Edward Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north, during the months of May, July, September and November

On-street accessible parking spaces to be installed:

Ward	Location
4	Cowan Avenue, west side, between a point 179.6 metres north of Springhurst Avenue and a point 5 metres further north
4	Jillson Avenue, south side, between a point 92 metres west of Windermere Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west
9	Macaulay Avenue, north side, between a point 58.5 metres east of Sousa Mendes Street and a point 5.5 metres further east
9	Prescott Avenue, east side, between a point 66 metres south of Rockwell Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south, from the 16 th day to the last day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
9	Prescott Avenue, west side, between a point 75 metres south of Rockwell Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south, from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive, and from the first day to the 15 th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
12	Humewood Drive, east side, between a point 43.2 metres north of Maplewood Avenue and a point 4 metres further north
12	Humewood Gardens, south side, between a point 41.7 metres east of Arlington Avenue and a point 5 metres further east
14	Redwood Avenue, east side, between a point 79.2 metres north of Gerrard Street East and a point 6 metres further north, from the 1 st day to the 15 th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
14	Redwood Avenue, west side, between a point 73.7 metres north of Gerrard Street East and a point 6.2 metres further north, from December 1 of one

year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive, and from the 16th day to the last day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive

- 19 Scarborough Road, east side, between a point 9 metres north of Queen Street East and a point 5.5 metres further north
