

Realignment of Permit Parking Area 6G to exclude the development located at 203 Jarvis Street

SUMMARY

Transportation Services is requesting approval from City Council to prohibit the General Manager from accepting applications from residents of, visitors to, and tradespersons at the development property municipally known as 203 Jarvis Street for residential onstreet permit parking.

Transportation Services has assessed the realignment of permit parking area 6G and the exclusion of the development property located at 203 Jarvis Street as requested by Toronto and East York Community Council, Item TE11.67, on December 3, 2019. Transportation Services is recommending approval of the exclusion as it will not impact negatively on Jarvis Street residents.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Manager, Permits and Enforcement, Parking, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. City Council approve the amendment to Schedule B of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate a revised map of permit parking area "6G", as attached in Attachment A of the report dated December 12, 2019 from the Manager, Permits and Enforcement, Parking, Transportation Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact associated with this report.

At its meeting December 3, 2019 Toronto and East York Community Council in considering item TE11.67, requested Transportation Services to examine and report back to Toronto and East York Community Council regarding the realignment of permit parking area 6G to exclude the development at 203 Jarvis Street.

COMMENTS

Permit Parking area 6G is bounded by Jarvis Street on the west, Gerrard Street East to the north, Sherbourne Street to the east and Shuter Street to the south. Area 6N has 117. To date, 106 permits have been issued. This area does have a history of being waitlisted, meaning the demand for overnight on-street parking permits has exceeded the supply of parking spaces. There is TTC service on Jarvis Street.

As required under the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, the General Manager requested the City Clerk to provide Notice. A Public Notice was placed on the City's website requesting those objecting to the exclusion of 203 Jarvis Street, from permit parking area "6G" to forward their objections in writing to the City Clerk, so they may be scheduled as deputations at the Toronto and East York Community Council meeting.

Transportation Services has no objections to the exclusion of the development located at 203 Jarvis Street from permit parking area 6G.
