Re: 14.2 - Naming of an existing public lane North of Queen Street West extending Beverley Street and John Street.

The Grange Community Association respectfully requests that this report be deferred and that consideration be given to an alternate location.

Rationale:

- The GCA has communicated on several occasions with both the TEYCC as well as City staff advising that the association has been involved in a study of un-named laneways within our planning district, bounded by College, University, Queen and Spadina.
- The GCA provided both the TEYCC and City staff with an early list of laneways with proposed names.
- The GCA has not been consulted on the proposal before you regarding the above laneway.
- Two condominium boards adjacent to this laneway have not been consulted.
- The laneway identified for this proposal is currently located within a residential area. The proposal seeks to highlight contributions of a commercial nature.
- There are laneways within the commercial district south of Queen Street that are more appropriate for this recognition, such as the laneway south of Queen that runs between Duncan and John.
