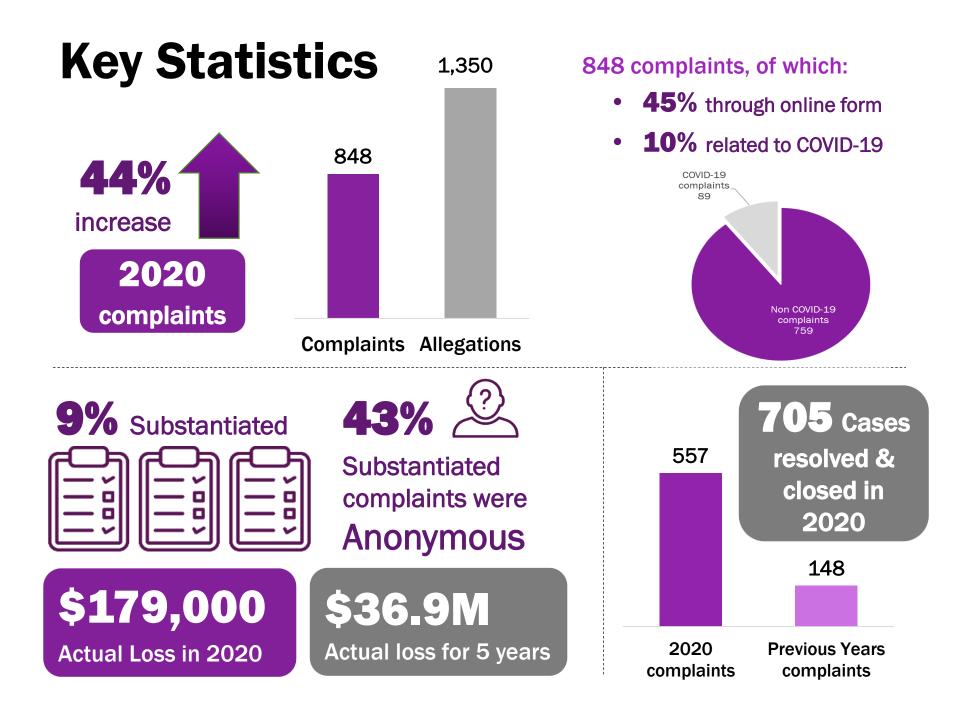

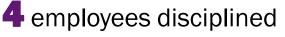

A lengthy & complex investigation into benefits fraud:

- Claimants reimbursed **\$38,000** since 2017
- **1** termination, **1** suspension
- All 3 cases referred to the Police

Communication Initiatives

- The responsibility to report wrongdoing is a part of the TPS By-law
- Direction from City Council to report allegations
- The initiatives will include undertaking an education campaign to raise awareness on employee responsibility to report wrongdoing to the Auditor General's Office
