Contract is expected to start on date of award and end on December 31, 2027.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award value identified in this report is \$5,531,015 net of applicable taxes and charges, \$6,250,047 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$5,628,361 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$4,984,064 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2021-2030 approved Capital Budget and Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 as follows.
