FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$19,028,432 including all applicable taxes and charges. The total cost to the City is \$19,363,333 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$15,273,318 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is available in the 2021 Approved Capital Budget and the 2022-2030 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 as follows:
