Contract is expected to start on date of award and end on December 31, 2021.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$988,200 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$889,905 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$982,200 net of all taxes and charges.
