Description:

For the non-exclusive supply and delivery First Aid Supplies to various Purchasing and Materials Management (Stores) locations from the date of award to May 30, 2022, with the option to renew the Contract for additional four (4) years period at the sole discretion of the City and subject to budget approval(s).

Prior to the renewal of the contract, PMMD will perform a market analysis to verify the current market conditions as compared to the proposed increase by the vendor and that the Stores Division will monitor vendor performance during the first term of the contract.

Should the option(s) be exercised, then the Manager of Materials Management and Stores will request the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management to process the renewals under the same terms and conditions.

The total potential contract award including all option years is \$2,248,249 including all applicable taxes and chargers and \$1,989,602 net of all applicable taxes and charges. The total potential cost to the City including all options years for all awards is \$2,024,619 net of HST Recoveries.

The above cost calculations for the Option Years reflect an estimated annual 3% increase as per the Consumer Price Index (CPI).

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total potential contract award identified in this report is \$2,248,250 including all applicable taxes and charges. The total potential cost to the City is \$2,024,619 net of HST recoveries.

The materials on this contract will be purchased for PMMD Stores inventory purposes. The material value will be held in inventory holding Balance Sheet accounts (160004, 160026, 160049, 160067, 160068, 160082, 160083, 160085, 160171) until City Divisions require the material to support their work programs at which time the material value is charged to the appropriate Divisions' approved operating budgets.

Funding from the date of award to December 31, 2021 is available in the appropriate Divisions' 2021 Operating Budgets and should all the option years be exercised, appropriate additional funding will be requested in their 2022-2026 Operating Budget Submissions. The details are as follows:
