Description:

To provide all labour, equipment, materials, and supervision for the renovations and upgrades of Earlscourt Park Building 6 on behalf of the Parks, Forestry and Recreation Division of the City of Toronto.

Recommended Supplier:

Joe Pace & Sons Contracting Inc.

Contract Award Value:

\$1,113,000 net of all applicable taxes and charges \$1,257,690 including HST and all applicable charges **\$1,132,589 net of HST recoveries**

The contract is expected to start following the date of award and end by April 30, 2022.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$1,257,690 including all applicable taxes and charges. The total cost to the City is \$1,132,589 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$1,035,000 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding for this project is included in the 2021 Council Approved Capital Budget and 2022-2030 Capital Plan for Parks, Forestry, and Recreation as summarized in Table 1 below.
