**Re: EX25.1 – Recognition Review Project Update and Response to the Dundas Street Renaming Petition**  
**– Follow up Letter**

In our letter to the Executive Committee, we requested that the composition of the proposed change be amended and that a fund be established to provide support for affected businesses and residents should a change be implemented. See below for our recommendations.

“Amend recommendation #2 of the City Manager’s report so that the composition of the proposed advisory committee is more reflective of those who are affected by the proposed change; and  
Increase the funding allocation to provide support for businesses and residents who will be affected.”

We note that the amendment approved by the Executive Committee **did not** address our concern regarding the composition of the Advisory Committee.

There is a principle in government that “taxation include representation”. The proposed composition of the advisory committee does not reflect this principle.

Once again, we ask that the proposed advisory committee include representation from residents’ associations and business organizations. We also ask that City Council address compensation to affected businesses and residents.
