Pursuant to the City of Toronto, Municipal Code Chapter 349 -15.1 you are hereby ordered to:
Muzzle the dog forthwith except when the dog is on the premises* of the owner; ("Premises" means that portion of the property for which the dog owner has exclusive possession)
Post a warning sign at the following location(s) on the premises: Front and Side entraines
sign must be clearly and conspicuously posted and a minimum size of 8.5" by 11". 3. Prohibit the dog from entering into a designated leash-free area of a City park at any
time; 4. Obtain a dangerous dog tag;
5. Ensure the dog is identified with a microchip and provide proof of compliance within 14
days of the date of this order; 6. Enable the City to collect a photograph of the dog; and
7. Ensure the dog receives socialization / obedience training within 90 days of the date of this order and provide proof of compliance within 14 days of achieving compliance.
In accordance with the City of Toronto, Municipal Code Chapter 349, § 349-16, you may request and are entitled to a hearing by the Executive Director, who may rescind the determination of a dangerous dog and exempt you from compliance with the aforementioned requirements. Although a hearing may be requested, an order to comply with the aforementioned requirements, takes effect when the order is served.
To receive a hearing, you must mail or deliver to the Executive Director within thirty (30) days after a copy of the Dangerous Dog Order is served, notice in writing requesting a hearing, accompanied by the applicable
