The Executive Director has reason to believe that the dog indicated above has engaged in a dangerous act against a person or domestic animal on the day of 20_20 at approximately and that the dangerous act was severe or is the second or subsequent dangerous act on record with the City.
Pursuant to the City of Toronto, Municipal Code Chapter 349 -15.1 you are hereby ordered to: 1. Muzzle the dog forthwith except when the dog is on the premises* of the owner; ("Premises" means that portion of the property for which the dog owner has exclusive possession)
2. Post a warning sign at the following location(s) on the premises:
In accordance with the City of Toronto, Municipal Code Chapter 349, § 349-16, you may request and are entitled to a hearing by the Executive Director, who may rescind the determination of a dangerous dog and exempt you from compliance with the aforementioned requirements. Although a hearing may be requested, an order to comply with the aforementioned requirements, takes effect when the order is served. To receive a hearing, you must mail or deliver to the Executive Director within thirty (30) days after a copy of
the Dangerous Dog Order is served, notice in writing requesting a hearing, accompanied by the applicable fee, to:
