On February 23, 2021, the CNEA received formal notice of commencement of the negotiations respecting the development of phase II of Hotel X from Exhibition Place. We have been monitoring the discussions and presentations as to the scope of the development and have been requested by Mr. Bob Hunter to provide a letter of support for the project.

This 7000 seat e-gaming and concert facility can be a substantial, positive addition to the facilities at Exhibition Place. As you know, the CNEA has lived through many transitions and redevelopments on the Exhibition Place grounds. We have adapted and flourished despite the challenges that redevelopment often present.

The CNE has been a promoter of e-gaming since 2017 with major partners such as AMD and has been a promoter of concerts and music performances throughout its history. The introduction of new facilities that are designed to facilitate these types of events can only be a positive.
