

Contracts awarded under extended authority of the Bid Award Panel during 2020

SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to advise the General Government and Licensing Committee of the Contracts valued over \$20 million awarded in 2020 under the extended authority of the Bid Award Panel in accordance with the Section 195-8.3, A & B of the Municipal Code, Chapter 195, Purchasing. This report covers both Contract awards when Committees and Council were cancelled due to COVID-19 and then during the summer recess in 2020.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Chief Procurement Officer recommends that:

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are no financial implications associated with this report.

DECISION HISTORY

In accordance with Chapter 195, of the Toronto Municipal Code, Section 195-8.3A sets out the conditions when the Bid Award Panel is authorized to exercise the power of a Standing Committee to make an Award of a Contract that exceeds \$20,000,000 excluding all taxes. Section 195.8.3B requires that the award shall be reported by the Chief Procurement Officer to the General Government and Licensing Committee for information.

COMMENTS

In 2020, due to COVID-19, Standing Committees and Council was cancelled in April and May, resulting in the Bid Award Panel being able to exercise the delegated authority under Section 195-8.3A(1) (where regularly scheduled meetings of Standing Committees and Council have been cancelled). Further, Council went on summer recess in August, 2020, resulting in the Bid Award Panel being able to exercise the delegated authority under Section 195-8.3A (3).

Three contracts were awarded by the Bid Award Panel that exceeded \$20 million under the extended authority of the Bid Award Panel during 2020 as shown in Table 1 below.

As required by the Purchasing By-law, the contracts were awarded to either the lowest bidder meeting specifications or the highest scoring proponent. Further, each of them were budgeted for in the appropriate capital or operating budget and received financial approval from Financial Planning. Finally, all of the Contracts noted below closed and the evaluation was completed at a point where they could not report to the appropriate Standing Committee, which necessitated the use of the delegated authority for Bid Award Panel.
