

AMPLIFIED LIVE MUSIC ON PATIOS PILOT

As Toronto safely reopens, the Live Music on Patios Pilot aims to add energy and vitality to participating main streets, encouraging people to return to their favourite restaurants and bars, as well as visit local shops and services.

By permitting restaurants, bars and venues to hire musicians to perform on CaféTO patios, the program will also help local artists, who have been among the hardest hit by the COVID-19 pandemic.



Owners and operators of a CaféTO main street patio located in one of the three pilot wards are eligible to participate from July 29 to October 31.

The participating wards include Beaches-East York, Toronto-Danforth and Davenport.

Amplified live music is permitted within the following scheduled times:

Thursdays and Fridays, 5 to 10 p.m.

Saturdays, noon to 10 p.m.

Sundays, noon to 6 p.m.

City Supports Available for this Pilot

Participating venues can obtain advice from the City's Music Office on the logistics of hosting a musical performance, such as:

- renting and setting up a public address system to amplify music appropriately
- measuring and limiting music volume to respect neighbours and comply with the Noise Bylaw
- configuring patio space for musical performances
- booking and working with artists using the Music Office's Musician Directory.

Financial Support

The City created the CaféTO BIA Grant Program:
Amplified Live Music Pilot fund

- Maximum \$10K per BIA
- To be spent by the BIA in direct support of the pilot i.e. programming, production, promotion
- Applications opened July 30 and accepted until Oct. 1st.

What We're Asking from Participating Venues

- Participating venues must ensure every element of the pilot is fully compliant with the City of Toronto noise by-law, all COVID measures, and all other pertinent regulation, such as maintaining the pedestrian clearway free of cables or any other obstruction.
- Participation in the City's data-gathering throughout the pilot.
- Fair compensation for musicians.
- Promotion through the participant's customary channels.

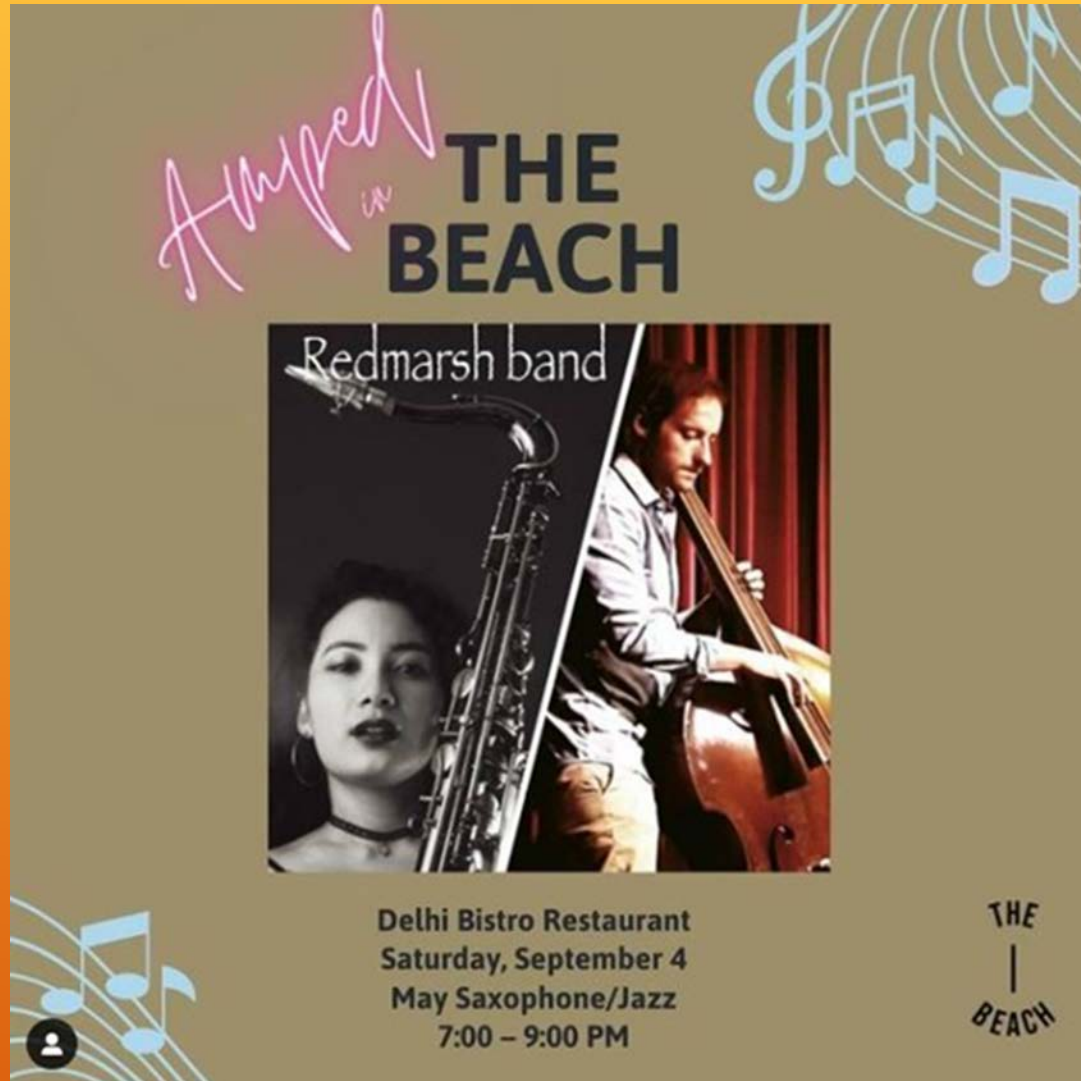


- 9 BIAs applied and received \$85K in grant funding

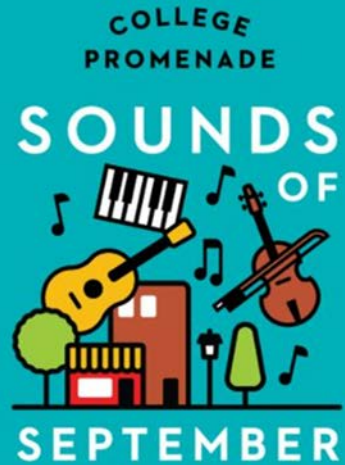
