Dear Mayor Tory and City Councillors,

We support the motion MM31.27 for a request of a comprehensive planning evaluation of the Canada Square site to reflect what midtown and the City need at this important location.

At a minimum, this review should include extensive consideration of community services; schools; affordable housing; built form; parks and open spaces; cultural space; economic development; public art; and transit infrastructure.

In addition, it's vital that the community be able to participate in the planning study and have meaningful input and say in the outcome.

We also ask that a report be prepared with guiding principles for the redevelopment of the site to be presented for approval to City Council and prior to City Planning's competition of their evaluation of Oxford Development's rezoning application.

We will never again get such an opportunity in midtown Toronto to create a complete community within our boundaries. We should have the vision and the courage to think big and build something great and lasting.
