Re: NYCC NY23.16 Parking Amendments – Wilson Avenue April 20, 2021

The South Armour Heights Residents' Association ("SAHRA") is the residents' association for 850 homes in the area within the boundaries of the west side of Yonge Blvd over to the east side of Avenue Road, from the 401 down to the south side of Brooke Ave.

Agenda Item NY23.16 relates to Parking Amendments on Wilson Avenue, near Belgrave Avenue. This is within our area and has been of interest and concern to SAHRA for some time.

SAHRA supports the recommended change in the existing stopping prohibition in effect from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays, on the north side of Wilson Avenue, between Belgrave Avenue and a point 167.5 metres west, **to be in effect from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays.**

In SAHRA's opinion, it is unsafe to allow drop-off or pick-up of students in this high-traffic area. Furthermore, stopping or parking in this area would impede traffic.

We strongly support this recommendation by Traffic Management, Transportation Services regarding the existing stopping prohibition by the Armour Heights Public School.
